## FAITH HEALS

We've all heard stories about people withering away after the death of a spouse. In their book *Successful Aging*, physicians John W. Rowe and Robert L. Kahn review the health impact of being "socially connected". Several things about this connection seem to be important, and apply to all people. First, isolation - a lack of social ties - is a powerful risk factor for poor health. Second, emotional and physical social support seems not only to have positive effect on health, but also to buffer some health-related effects of aging. Being connected is far more than having people around to help with chores. It means having emotional connection. Loving support is an essential ingredient in good health, and it's important for all of us. The need for such interactions is spotlighted by studies of children who have grown up in complete isolation from other human beings. We are made not to live alone, but to interact regularly with others. And then THERE IS FAITH. Herbert Benson, M.D. a professor at Harvard Medical School, has identified a "faith factor" in physical and emotional healing. In his book *Beyond the Relaxation Response*, he describes faith as a method of natural healing that can help many health problems. Studies in the past decade show positive relationships between strong personal faith and problems including anxiety, alcohol abuse, depression and even high blood pressure. This link between the mind and the body seems strong. We are not made to live solitary lives. Unfortunately too many of us think of ourselves first. The irony is that by emphasizing our own needs instead of caring for others, we may hurt ourselves in the long run.
