## GRAND MARSHALL - JAMES and ANN SUTERA

Jim was born to Phillip and Mary Sutera. Ann was born to George and Cvita Vladovich. Both grew up in the Saint Jerome community. Jim's parents were born in Nicosia, Sicily. Ann's parents were born in Selo-Kotlenice. Ann is a graduate of Saint Jerome's. On November 22, 1947, Jim and Ann were married at Saint Jerome's Church.

They have two children, James and Stephen who attended and received their sacraments at St. Jerome's. They also have three grandchildren.

Jim and Ann have spent the majority of their married life at 32<sup>nd</sup> and Princeton. They frequently could be seen attending various masses, particu-

larly Saturday evening mass at which Jim was a regular usher. Jim and Ann have been generous supporters of



the Saint Jerome's throughout their marriage. They are more affectionately known by many in the parish as "Uncle Jim" and "Auntie Annie." Jim was regularly seen in our processions


marching with the Holy Name Society, Club SINJ or the Catholic War Veterans. He regularly attended meetings for these organizations and participated in their activities. In the past, Jim was a "chauffeur" for Sister Benedict. Ann used to regularly iron altar clothes, vestments, and used to regularly iron for Sister Geraldine.

Unfortunately, after the church chose Jim and Ann as their Grand Marshalls for this year's August 15<sup>th</sup> procession, Jim passed away on May 13, 2004. Jim will be our Honorary Grand Marshall, along with Ann. Ann will be by her sons and their families.

## OUR LADY OF SINJ

Velika Gospa and being Croatian go hand-in-hand. This day (August 15th) is to Croatians what St. Patrick's Day is to the Irish, or what Columbus Day is to the Italians. The tradition of Velika Gospa originated in the town of Sinj, Croatia.

History tells us that in the year 1716, the barbaric armies of the Turkish Empire were advancing toward the town. Their plan was to capture Sinj and press forward. The Turks hoped, to conquer all of Europe. The people of Sinj, fearing certain annihilation in the face of overwhelming odds implored the intervention of the Blessed



Mother. Throughout the night of August 14th, they prayed before the portrait of the Virgin Mary then called "Our Lady of Grace." The following morning, Assumption Day, August 15th, an apparition of a beautiful lady, whom the faithful recognized as the Blessed Virgin Mary, appeared in the sky. The Turkish soldiers became violently

ill. They were unable to cross the river to Sinj, and thus retreated.

Through Our Lady of Sinj's miraculous intervention the attack was repulsed and the powerful Turks fled. Ever since that day the Croatians have maintained a unique love and devotion to Mary. Thousands of pilgrims still make the annual pilgrimage to the church in Sinj.

This religious tradition was brought to Chicago in 1912 with the blessing of a new parish for Bridgeport: St. Jerome Croatian Church, and thus began our feast of Velika Gospa.

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## VELIKA GOSPA....DID YOU KNOW.....?

- ◆ **That** our procession is in its 98th year. We are gearing up for a grand centennial celebration just two years away!
- ◆ **That** our Velika Gospa feast is the only specific celebration of Our Lady of Sinj outside of Sinj itself.
- ◆ **That** the city of Sinj, Croatia holds annual chivalry games known as the "Sinjska alka". This year marks the 289th running of the alka which is held in honor of Our Lady of Sinj in thanksgiving for a defeat against the Ottoman Turks in the year 1715.
- ◆ **That** the family of Valerie Babić, her friends and neighbors make a pilgrimage on foot to St. Jerome's from their homes in Justice, Illinois (about 15 miles away) which begins on the eve of Velika Gospa. They walk for Our Lady's feast day as a vow, walking for about 6 full hours.

## A VELIKA GOSPA MEMORY....

It was the early 1960's and I had just become an altar boy. As custom dictated in that era, each altar boy was required to serve one evening of mass during the Velika Gospa novena. Sadly for me at the time, I was chosen to serve on the night of August 14<sup>th</sup>, the eve of the Assumption. This duty meant that the nuns of St. Jerome would keep my fellow altar boys and me long after mass had ended to help prepare for the following day's holy celebration.

On the evening of the 14<sup>th</sup>, after the mass had ended and many of the parishioners had left our sweltering church for the comfort of their air-conditioned homes, we altar boys set off for our sacristy where we awaited orders from the nuns. While in the sacristy we began to hear whispering in the church. I poked my head out the sacristy door only to find my Baba and the Babas of my friends and fellow altar boys moving through the aisles of the church on their knees. Listening more attentively, I realized that their words were the prayers of the holy rosary. Quietly, I watched each older woman struggle to approach the picture of the Gospa while on their knees. Since the back of the Gospa's picture faced the altar, we watched each woman kiss the five points of the large M painted on the backside of the picture. Our eyes followed them as they returned to their knees and continued their procession around church while praying the rosary. In this group, I saw my Baba as she too struggled in her devotions.

It was some 20 years later that I traveled to Croatia and the Shrine of Sinj. As I approached the altar of our Gospa, I was again amazed to find elderly Croatian women on their knees praying the rosary around the Gospa Sinjska altar.
