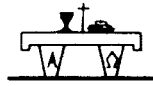

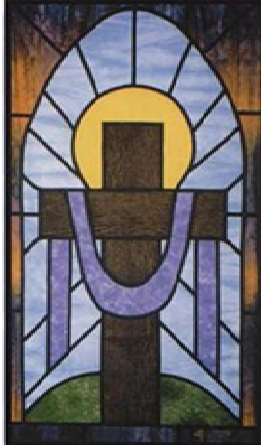

We love Christ. He changes our lives. He is the central point of our life reflections. Human hope is imbedded in him. Christ has made great things of our everyday simplicities:

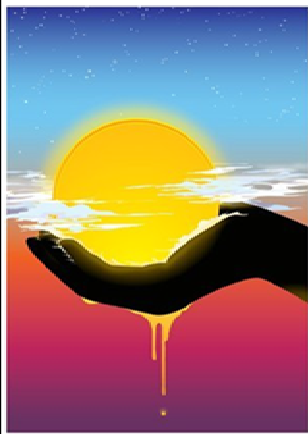
- ◆ He turned bad people into good,

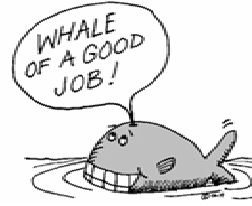
