

Food for the Journey

From a war zone in the Pacific during WWII, a non-Catholic soldier wrote this letter to a Catholic friend:

Ive had an airplane accident. The plane crashed and burst into flames. I was taken to a makeshift hospital. There was a boy in the next bed. Both his legs and one arm had been blown off and not much was left of his face. I'll never forget. Those great dark pain-filled eyes will haunt me the rest of my life.

A priest came to administer the last sacraments to him, and the young soldier's eyes took on a heavenly light. Pain seemed to be forgotten in those last sacred moments. You know, I have never been a religious man, but I felt the presence of a power much greater than all the devils of war. That holy priest held in his hand what seemed to be a small round disk, but I felt there was something beyond the human understanding in that small round wafer, for the boy's eyes rested upon it for a moment, then closed.

I saw the priest bend over him, then say a few hurried prayers. The boy had looked at his God through a veil of my stery, but when he opened his eyes again the veil was lifted, for he was face-to-face with God. How beautiful to die like that! How beautiful to live like that!

Next day I had a little talk with the Chaplain, who told me something about your religion. God helping me, I will embrace the faith that brought such heavenly light to a dying boy's eyes. God helping me, I will live for Him in the future. My only regret is that I havewasted so many years.

The Year 2009 is the 800th year in the life of the Franciscan Friar family.



There are many stories that capture the spirit and truth of St. Francis of Assisi. One of the best known is the legend of the wolf of Gubbio. The fierce wolf of that Italian town is said to have not only devoured animals,

but also some of the people. Francis, showing his conviction that all life comes from the one hand of God, addressed the wolf as "brother" and reprimanded the wolf for his cruel behavior. He did so "in the name of Christ Jesus" to proclaim it was not his human power at work, but the power of God invested in him by his baptism into Christ. Francis likewise promised that the people of the area woud provide food for the



wolf as long as he lives so that the animal would not need to revert to violence to obtain food. The wolf extended his right paw to Francis as a sign of peace and became like a meek and humble lamb. Francis also took the opportunity to tell the people of Gubbio that a greater wrath than that of the wolf will come upon them if they do not repent of their sins. Certainly Francis embodied the popular prayer that is attributed to him, "Make me an instrument of your peace. Where there is hatred let me sow your love." The words of the prophet Isaiah ring true, "Then the wolf shall be a guest of the lamb." (Isaiah 11:6).
