An incident occurred in the life of Francis of Assisi in 1206 that so well defines his relationship to God. After his radical conversion the previous year, Francis began to live extravagantly, but not by lavishing material goods upon himself. He became overly generous when a genuine need appeared, such as repairing the crumbling chapel of San Damiano. Peter Bernardone, his business-oriented father, was hardly enthusiastic about such activities of his son, which were touching his profits and making the family look a bit ridiculous. A confrontation between the son and father was arranged. Peter and his witnesses were on one side, and Francis was alone on the other side, dressed in his finest clothing and clutching a much disputed bag of coins. Guido, the local bishop, was in the center. Of course there was a crowd of spectators made up of priests, lawyers, beggars and others. Francis went apart from the crowd and returned naked. He then placed his clothing and the bag of coins at the feet of his father. The bishop, recognizing that a great mystery was taking place, covered Francis with his cloak. Francis then spoke: "Because I want to serve God alone from this time on, I am returning to my father the money about which he is so concerned, and also my clothing....Until now I have called Pietro di Bernardone my father. As of now I will only acknowledge our Father who is in heaven.
