

Having received from Jesus, we are expected to give something in return, not to him but to one another — unselfish giving of oneself in the service of others. Just as Jesus gave of himself unselfishly, especially on the Cross.

Being in communion with Jesus means being in unselfish communion with one another.

I read, I write, I listen, I look, and I ponder. My encounters with a variety of people almost always make me

That reality hits me whenever I sense a person's emptiness. Perhaps some people think that as a priest I am called to speak about the human spirit. This is true, but it is also everyone's duty. These weeks, as we celebrate the mysteries of our faith—the feasts of Pentecost, Holy Trinity, Corpus Christi—and as we celebrate the power of our sharing in the life of Christ, I reflect upon the place wherein the human spirit dwells.

I am afraid for the people who do not have a depth of spirit in their lives, whose spiritual dwelling place is filled, but filled with emptiness.

When we encounter Christ, we receive, we grow, we experience a reality that we never before knew existed.

Do we feel that our lives are empty, or that we are worn out? Let us take advantage of this season of summer to replenish our spiritual batteries with the power of the Holy Spirit. Let us not remain empty. Emptiness kills our spirits. Emptiness turns us into unhappy people.


## CLUB POLJICA "Bean Bag" Tournament
