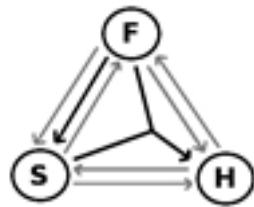

WEEKLY MEDITATION for Holy Trinity Sunday

The feast of the Holy Trinity brings us face to face with God in his revealed mystery.

We can determine certain things about God, but it is Jesus who reveals to us the mystery of God, and it is the Holy Spirit who guides us and carries on in the Church the work of the Son after Jesus ascended to the Fa-



ther. The Holy Spirit is the bond of love between the Father and the Son, and binds us to God.

Blessed are those who have a sense of God and of his presence in their lives. When we have a sense of God's presence in the world, we need no longer feel alone. God is all around us, but until

we discover that connection to us, he may seem to be remote. When we have experienced God's presence, solitude will never be loneliness.

One God in three persons, a God who is intimately close and yet utterly beyond us: this is a great mystery of love. The Christian lives in the world of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.
