"Deny yourself, take up your cross and follow me."

We need to ask these questions as we examine our conscience. A true disciple asks,

"Am I willing to sacrifice something for the kingdom?" How can I offer even the day-to-day sacrifices of my faith that demand things I don't want to do? Can I sacrifice some of my time in order to visit a homeless shelter or soup kitchen? Can I

sacrifice my job security and refuse to "go along" with a policy that is unjust? Can I sacrifice my need to be in control and let Christ do with me whatever he may will? Self denial means evicting selfish thoughts, desires and tendencies from our hearts and letting God fill our hearts. It also means being cleansed of all evil habits, enthroning God in in our hearts and sharing that God with others.

"Flashy cars? Meh. Young tech stars are putting their wealth into social causes and start-up ventures. The culture measures achievement by what entrepreneurs build, not what they buy." "Wealth needs a purpose greater than big houses and flashy cars," said Patzer, founder of Mint.com

At 27, Dustin Moskovitz is the world's youngest billionaire, according to Forbes. His thinking is interesting: "Things can't bring you happiness," Moskovitz said. "I have pictured myself owning expensive things and easily came to the conclusion that I would not have a materially more meaningful life because of them." Zuckerberg, a well known Facebook guy is another billionaire living below his means. For years, he crashed in a tiny apartment with a mattress on the floor and dial-up Internet access.
