# On Omaha Beach...

### Dear Friends,

PASTOR'S DESK

On my journey these days in Europe, I was in Normandy. An interesting place. History took place here in the beginning of June 1944 when the Americans and the British attacked Hitler's forces. About 80,000 allied soldiers were killed in Normandy alone.

It is very touching and emotionally powerful to stand at Omaha Beach and to come to the cemetery where 9,387 American soldiers are buried. Of these, 82 were brothers who died on June 5th and June 6th. Among them are the two brothers (Preston and Robert Niland) whose lives inspired the mega film, "Saving Private Ryan" (Block F: Row 15 : Graves 11 & 12). A third brother served in the Pacific and a fourth one was back home. Among the graves it is important to see a father and a son: Ollie Reed and Ollie Reed, Jr. Besides all of these graves, there is a wall of honor on which are inscribed the names of 1,557 soldiers whose bodies are missing. The cemetery is perfectly kept. White crosses with the names of the fallen along with their date of birth, date of death, the unit they served in, and, on the back of the cross, the number from their dog tag. I noticed that on some of the graves it simply said: "Known only to God."

At Omaha Beach you can feel the strength of the wind, the power of silence, and the history that is ever present. German bunkers are still here, and their machine guns as well, as if it all happened yesterday. The German cemetery is not far away with 21,000 buried and a black cross above the graves. It all reminds me of the Roman quote (Ciceronian): *Historia est magistra vitae*. History is the tutor of life.
