WEEKLY MEDITATION for the Sixth Sunday of Easter

The purpose of the indwelling Holy Spirit is to help us grow toward maturity and wholeness. We all have faults that prevent our growth: blocks of sin and weakness, blocks due to childhood conflicts, blocks due to deeply ingrained personality traits and habits, blocks caused by addictions, and blocks resulting from bad choices we have made.

We all have these blocks

within our spiritual hearts, and they hinder us from becoming what God wants us to be. They can prevent us from growing into maturity and wholeness.

God the Holy Spirit helps us see the truth about ourselves, to discern the blocks that inhibit our growth and to allow him to transform us. Like the good counselor that he is, the Holy Spirit enables us to become

stronger. The Holy Spirit comes to our aid and gives us the strength to make difficult and painful decisions.

The Holy Spirit begins to live in us at baptism. In a state of grace, and with a purified heart, we can hear the voice of the Holy Spirit, counseling and guiding us in the way of truth. Let us purify ourselves so we can better hear him and to obey his promptings.

Pope to Visit Croatia Next Weekend

Pope Benedict XVI will make his first journey as Pope to Croatia when he visits Zagreb on Saturday, June 4 and Sunday, June 5. The visit's motto is "Together in Christ."

Blessed John Paul II visited Croatia three times.

We in the U.S. can follow Pope Benedict's visit live on EWTN, the Catholic cable network: Comcast channel 119, Dish TV channel 261 and DirectTV channel 370.

Saturday, June 4th

The Pope arrives at the International Airport of Zagreb. There will be a welcoming ceremony at the airport and an Address by the Holy Father.

The Pope will pay a courtesy visit to the President of the Republic at the Presidential Palace. Following that, there will be an audience with the Prime Minister of Croatia at the Apostolic Nunciature of Zagreb.

The Pope will meet with representatives of civil society – the political, academic, cultural, and business worlds, the diplomatic corps, and religious leaders – at the National Croatian Theatre, with an Address by the Holy Father.

There will be a Prayer Vigil with Croatian young people in Ban Josip Jelačić Square, with an Address by the Holy Father.

Sunday, June 5th

Holy Mass on the occasion of the National Day of Croatian Catholic Families will be celebrated at the Zagreb Racecourse. There will be a recitation of the Regina Caeli.

There will be Evening Prayer with Bishops, Priests, Religious People, and Seminarians, and prayer at Blessed Alojzije Cardinal Stepinac's tomb at the Cathedral of Zagreb.

The Pope will visit Josip Cardinal Bozanic, the Archbishop of Zagreb, at his residence.

There will be a farewell ceremony at the International Airport of Zagreb, with an Address by the Holy Father, before departing for Rome.

Please pray for a safe, fruitful visit.
