The saintly, the sisters, and the special angels of St. Jerome's

My earliest memories of St. Jerome are of going to Church with my very saintly grandmother, Bubby (Budich). Holy

Saturday was very special. Bubby carried a huge cloth-covered basket that contained the food that would be our Ester dinner. Father blessed the food. The sight of all the women in Church with their baskets was a never to be forgotten memory.

When I was 16, Sister Callista told me that an organist was needed for the 11:30 Mass. While I was already playing accordion, I had no knowledge of the organ.



She said she would teach me, which she did. Her words were that God gave me the gift of music which I should use wisely the rest of my life (which I have). I continued as 11:30 organist from 1952 to 1958 and eventually played for 4 other churches.

I moved to Wisconsin in 1965. With Sister Callista's words ringing in my ears I became a professional accordionist for 13 years. The past 9 years I have been directing and performing with a group of seniors. We volun-


teer our time and talents at 3 senior facilities every month of year. Thank you, Sister Callista, for starting me on this path.

Now to the other "Special Angels" in my life, my aunts — Auntie Tate (Kate Siani) and Auntie Dolly (Ann Sexauer). I went through a very rocky patch in my life and turned away from my faith. Auntie Tate said my novenas to St. Anthony over and over and Doily

talked to me over and over about returning to the Catholic Church. After seeing how Auntie Tate survived some horrific things in her life, without ever losing her faith and Dolly never losing her faith even while dying with cancer — their many prayers finally helped me. Today I consider myself a good practicing Catholic; although I am now very much alone, I tell myself let go, let God, and never forget your special angels and St. Jerome's.


- Novena: Our traditional Novena in honor of the Feast of the Assumption continues this evening at 7:00 p.m. We invite you to join us!
