> caught up in the small worlds of our own minds, but open to the tremendous power of the Holy Spirit, who moves and transforms, creates and reconciles, a maker of a better world.


Yes, this Christmas we wish that every person of St. Jerome be an instrument of His peace, that this legacy be in the permanent possession of
