WEEKLY MEDITATION FOR TRINITY SUNDAY

We celebrated the Easter Season with the Resurrection of Christ as the focal point. The Easter Season tells us much about Christ himself.

Remembering the '70s, singing like we were back home in Croatia

It was back in the '70s, I believe in 1975, one Midnight Mass in particular stands out in my memory. Our Franciscans would occasionally open their home and treat us to refreshments after Midnight Mass. If I remember correctly, Fr. Marko Kozina and Fr. Ivan Bradvica were the priests at that time. During these years, many young people were emigrating from Croatia. Young people, always happy, didn't need much to start singing, especially after a drink or two. We sang Christmas carols, of course. We began singing in the house and then at two o'clock in the morning, headed down Princeton Avenue, singing as loudly as our voices would carry. I had a feeling that we were somewhere back home at a Dalmatian party or in a Slavonian village, not in the heart of America, in the city of Chicago. This is one of my fond memories from my early days here in Chicago.

A nun as an inspiration and example

Being from a large family of 12, I was proud to say that "my sister is a nun." Mary Bozich (Sr. M. Loretta) left home after St. Jerome's 8th



grade to go to Columbia, Pennsylvania, for high school and further studies to prepare her for being an Adorer of the Blood of Christ. She also would become a Mother Provincial. We all had numerous dis-

cussions with her about our faith, and she always had the proper answers. She was truly a woman of faith and a handmaid of the Lord. She taught us all to be better Christians and to appreciate our heritage and St. Jerome's. She was an inspiration to all of us.

Sr. Loretta died at the age of 87 on December 4th of 2004 and was buried at the motherhouse grounds at Columbia, Pa. We had a beautiful memorial Mass for her at St. Jerome Church, followed by a dinner at St. Jerome hall, where we all recounted our memories of her. Her religious Order was very strict. I remember I was in high school when my brother Mark ("Motsy") and Vera were married at St. Jerome and the reception was in the school hall. Sr. Loretta was in the convent next door, but she was not allowed to attend the reception. She could not sleep at our house and she always had to have a nun companion with her.

She was truly a woman of the Lord. She was always calm and collected and was able to defend the faith clearly and well. She showed us the way and taught us by word and example so much about Christian life and the unselfish way of living.
