WEEKLY MEDITATION for the Second Sunday of Lent

What did the Transfiguration experience on Mount Tabor mean for Jesus and his three apostles?

It came at a very difficult time in his life on earth. He was headed for Jerusalem, where he predicted that the same fate awaited him as befell all the prophets — a violent death.

To reflect and pray, he climbed to the top of Mount Tabor with his three closest apostles

There they had an intense experience of the presence of God.

They heard those marvelous words addressed to Jesus: "You are my beloved Son." On Mount Tabor Jesus was affirmed. The apostles knew that the Father was pleased with him. With God on their side, they could face anything.

At times life can become dark for all of us, but there is a still,

small voice that whispers to us in our hearts: "You are my beloved child." This is the voice we need to pay attention to. As God's beloved children, we need try to live our lives by the light of this truth.

To know that nothing can separate us from the love of God is our strength in times of weakness and our hope in times of adversity. In the face of pain, all we have to do is abandon ourselves to his care.
