WEEKLY MEDITATION for the 23rd Sunday of Ordinary Time

The Gospel today talks about the deaf man with speech impediments. It gives us opportunity to reflect on the gift of hearing and speech.

“Listening, like other skills, can be developed through practice, or lost if not used regularly. Good listeners focus on what they are hearing. They pause to

think about what they’ve heard before responding. They ask questions because they want to know the answers, not just to keep the conversation going. In Africa, listening is a guiding principle. It’s a principle that’s been lost amid the constant chatter of the Western world, where no one seems to have the time or even the desire to listen to any-

one else. Many people make the mistake of confusing information with knowledge. They are not the same thing. Knowledge involves the interpretation of information. Knowledge involves listening. If we are storytelling creatures, and as long as we permit ourselves to be quiet for a while now and then, the eternal narrative will continue.”
