#### **5TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

#### **Blessed Aloysius Stepinac**

Aloysius Viktor Stepinac was a cardinal and Archbishop of Zagreb, Croatia, from 1937 to 1960. In 1998 he was declared a martyr and beatified by Pope John Paul II.

Stepinac was ordained on October 26, 1930 by archbishop Giuseppe Palica, and in 1931 he became a parish curate in Zagreb. He established the archdiocesan branch of Caritas in 1931, and was appointed coadjutor to the archdiocese of Zagreb in 1934. When Archbishop Anton Bauer died on December 7, 1937, Stepinac suc-



ceeded him as the Archbishop of Zagreb. During World War II, on 6 April 1941, Yugoslavia was invaded by Nazi Germany, and the Independent State of Croatia was established. As archbishop of the state's capital, Stepinac objected against the persecution of Jews and Nazi laws, helped Jews and others to escape and criticized Ustaše atrocities in front of Zagreb Cathedral in 1943.

After the war he publicly condemned the new Yugoslav government and its actions during World War II, especially for murders of priests by Communist militants. Yugoslav authorities indicted the archbishop on multiple counts of war crimes and collaboration with the enemy during wartime. The trial was depicted in the West as a typical communist "show trial", biased against the archbishop. In a verdict the Yugoslav authorities found him guilty of collaboration with the fascist Ustaše movement and complicity in allowing the forced conversions of Orthodox Serbs to Catholicism.

After foreign and domestic pressure, Stepinac was released from Lepoglava prison. In 1952 he was appointed cardinal by Pope Pius XII. Stepinac died while still under confinement in his parish, almost certainly as the result of poisoning by his Communist captors. In October 3, 1998, Blessed Pope John Paul II declared him a martyr and beatified him before 500,000 Croatians in Marija Bistrica near Zagreb. His feast day is celebrated on February 10.

What is it about heroism that captures the human heart? Stepinac, a defender of life in its purest sense, was a restless, righteous spirit: What the Nazis sought to destroy, he fought to save. When nations turned a blind eye to those cruelly victimized, he shed a light as bright as heaven on them. He spoke for those whose own voices were muffled. Simply put, Stepinac wasn't afraid to stand up. He proves that speaking out is a noble act. Stepinac's life exemplifies the passage from the Talmud: "Whoever saves one life is as though he had saved the entire world."

#### **CARDINAL STEPINAC WAY**

One memorable event in our parish history took place during the visit of blessed Pope John Paul II to Croatia (October 2-4, 1998) when he beatified Cardinal Aloysius Stepinac. At the same time, on October 3, the Mayor of the City of Chicago, Richard M. Daley, proclaimed the 3rd day of October, 1998 as Cardinal Stepinac Day for the City of Chicago. By the same act, the Mayor granted the Croatian community in Chicago and, in a special way to St. Jerome's Parish, a street named after this honorable and blessed Cardinal. Namely, Princeton Avenue between 26th and 33rd streets was designated as "Cardinal Stepinac Way". This is a very important decision for our community especially because it is this street through which for more than 85 years St. Jerome Parish has held its famous Velika Gospa procession. The solemn moment of dedication took place on Sunday, April 18, 1999. We were privileged to have His Excellency Francis Cardinal George, Archbishop of Chicago for the solemn opening.

#### LENTEN FAST AND ABSTINENCE

The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops has declared that "the age of fasting is from the completion of the 18th year to the beginning of the 60th." The USCCB also allows the substitution of some other form of penance for abstinence on all of the Fridays of the year, except for those Fridays in Lent. Thus, the rules for fasting and abstinence in the United States are:

- Every person 14 years of age or older must abstain from meat on <u>Ash Wednesday</u>, <u>Good Friday</u>, and all the Fridays of <u>Lent</u>.
- Every person between the age of 18 and 60 must fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- Every person 14 years of age or older must abstain from meat on all other Fridays of the year, unless he or she substitutes some other form of penance for abstinence.
