### Dear friends, neighbors and parishioners,

Every day our lives create a new history filled with various events, encounters and experiences. As this old year comes to an end and the new one begins, I find myself reflecting on my many years spent here with all of you at St. Jerome's. I look back and share these memories with you... After my arrival here, I felt myself feeling at home very quickly. People were very accepting of me and I felt loved by everyone and I felt that same love towards everyone. Even then I realized that a person feels at home when he finds love. where love is real, where it is active, where it is shown. and where it is alive. I remember how so many of you accepted me immediately and did everything to make me feel comfortable and at home. I wanted to return those gestures of love and kindness from day to day, week to week and event to event. So many events, so many encounters, so much joy shared as your children were baptized, received their first holy communion, were confirmed, married, as we celebrated wedding anniversaries and birthdays. It was a difficult time for me as well. I cried as well, alone in the car, on the way back from the hospital, retirement homes, a place of

tragedy, or your family's home ... unfortunately, sadness is a part of our lives and it caused me to reflect on an old saving, "Shared joy is doubled joy, shared pain is only half the pain." I was truly affected by the experiences of so many of you here at St. Jerome's. I was never the same. I realized that life is a great gift, people are a gift, and it's worth it to spend our valuable gift of time in love, in giving, in unselfishness, and in total giving to the fullest. Many of those whom I met became an inspiration to me. People involved in our community, who always give of themselves, who ask for nothing in return, who give and keep on giving. Their hearts have become even bigger by giving, and their souls filled with peace. And they never complained to anybody about anything! That's where I gained in wisdom that our lives have the most meaning when we inspire others. That is a beautiful life. At the same time I was deeply saddened for the selfish people who kept to themselves, who stayed closed up in their own little worlds that revolved around their own interests and their own narrow views.
