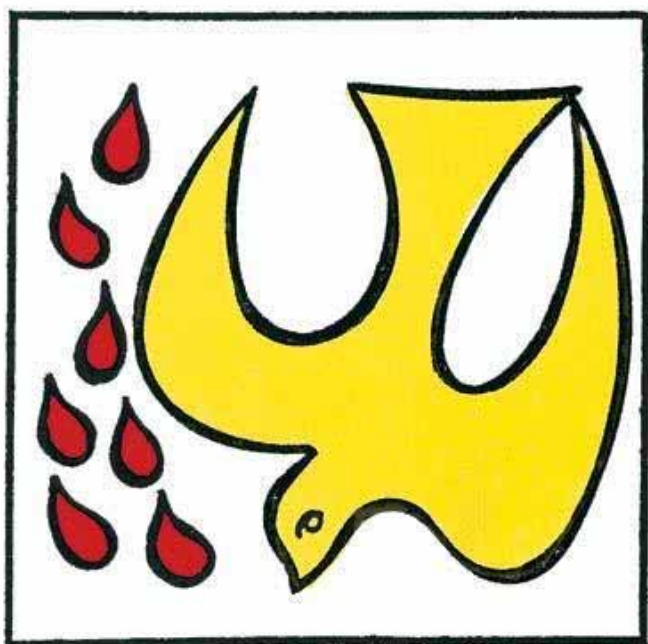

PENTECOST SUNDAY

The Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles individually and collectively. Filled with the Holy Spirit, they began their mission. We see the great courage and confidence with which they did so. The same Spirit descends on us at our Baptism and Confirmation. The Spirit gives us power to participate in the work of Jesus. The Holy Spirit is our strength in times of weakness, our guide in times of doubt, our consoler in times of sadness, and our advocate who always pleads our cause.

The Spirit we have been given is not a spirit of timidity, but the Spirit of power, the Spirit of God. The coming of the Spirit provided the apostles with the energy, the courage, and the love to get on with the task Christ had given them. Before the coming of the Spirit, the apostles were virtually living in hiding in the upper room. A great task had been entrusted to them, yet they had neither the strength nor the will to begin it. However, after Pentecost they were changed people. They left their hiding place and set out courageously to preach the Gospel.

All of us have a capacity for goodness. We have hands that can care, eyes that can see, ears that can hear, tongues that can speak, feet that can walk, and above all hearts that can love. Yet we need someone to awaken us to what is inside us. For us followers of Jesus, that someone is the Holy Spirit. The power that changed the apostles is available to us too - the gentle power of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit awakens us to the mysterious power within us, bids us live, and helps us grow. That is what the Spirit did for the apostles, and that is what the Holy Spirit does for us.

PEDESETNICA - DUHOVI

Svetkovina Duhova još se naziva i pedesetnica jer je 50. dan nakon Uskrsa. Uskršno otajstvo se razvija kroz 7 tjedana ($7 \times 7 = 49$), a kulminira 50. dan, u jednoj dugoj uskrsnoj svečanosti, blagdanom Duhova. Djela apostolska govore o onome što se u Jeruzalemu dogodilo 50. dan nakon Isusova uskrsnuća. Na Sinaju je Bog govorio Mojsiju iz ognja i grmljavine, a sada je sišao Duh Sveti, prozborivši vatrenim jezicima, obraćajući se ženama i apostolima koji su se u molitvi okupili oko Marije, Majke Isusove. Nije li to lijepa slika: žene i muževi zajedno na početku Crkve!

Kao što je primanjem Deset zapovijedi sklopljen Božji savez s njegovim narodom, tako se prihvaćanjem Radosne vijesti da je Uskrsnuli Isus od Boga poslani Mesija, sklapa Novi Božji savez s ljudima. Ne samo prihvaćanjem u kamentu napisanih zapovijedi, nego u vjeri u Boga, koji nas susreće utjelovljen, ljudi nalaze svoj spas i svoje savršenstvo.

Što se to dogodilo u Jeruzalemu? Onima koji su nakon Isusove smrti pali u duboku krizu, sumnju i malodušnost uspjelo je smoći snage i krenuti dalje, i svoja iskustva s Isusom Kristom pripovijedati drugima. To što im je uspjelo prevladati krizu vjere i života nisu smatrali svojom zaslugom, nego posljedicom milosti Boga kojemu su se otvorili molitvom. Osjećali su da Otac ne djeluje samo po Isusu Kristu za spasenje ljudi, nego i po nama samima. On nas osposobljuje na novi način izreći Isusove riječi koje donose slobodu. On nam daje snagu da i mi radimo za spasenje ljudi. Učenici osjećaju kako svi ljudi mogu doživjeti tu milost, kao i oni sami nakon Isusova uskrsnuća.

„Isus dahne u njih i kaže im: primite Duha Svetoga!“ (Iv 20, 22). Kao dah, brzo i jedva čujno, a ipak prodorno i preobražavajuće, Duh Božji ispunja čovjeka. Paralela se može povući s izvješćem o stvaranju svijeta, u trenutku kad Božji dah daruje život čovjeku. Da bi mogli nastaviti poslanje, učenici dobivaju dar Duha Svetoga koji je životvorac. On uvodi učenike u istinu. Ako im je potrebna pomoć da razumiju istinu koja je Isus, još im je potrebnije da shvaćenu istinu navješćuju svim narodima.

WHAT IS CONFIRMATION?

Confirmation is the sacrament that completes Baptism; in it the gift of the Holy Spirit is bestowed upon us. Those who freely decide to live a life as God's child and ask for God's Spirit under the signs of the imposition of hands and anointing with chrism receive the strength to witness to God's love and might in words and deeds. They become a responsible members of the Catholic Church.



WHAT DOES BIBLE SAY ABOUT THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION?

In the Old Testament, the people of God expected the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Messiah. Jesus lived his life in a special Spirit of love and of perfect unity with his Father in heaven. This Spirit of Jesus was the "Holy Spirit" for whom the people of Israel longed; this was the same Spirit whom Jesus promised to his disciples, the same Spirit who descended upon the disciples 50 days after Easter, on the feast of Pentecost. And it is again this same Holy Spirit of Jesus who descends upon everyone who receives the Sacrament of Confirmation.

WHAT HAPPENS IN CONFIRMATION?

In Confirmation the soul of a baptized Christian is imprinted with a permanent seal that can be received only once and marks this individual for ever as a Christian. The gift of the Holy Spirit is the strength from above in which this individual puts the grace of his Baptism into practice through his life and acts as a "witness" for Christ.

WHO CAN BE CONFIRMED, AND WHAT IS REQUIRED OF A CANDIDATE?

Any Catholic Christian who has received the Sacrament of Baptism and is in the "state of grace" can be admitted to Confirmation.

WHAT ARE GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT?

The gifts of the Holy Spirit are wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety and fear of the Lord. With these the Holy Spirit "endows" Christians - he grants them particular powers that go beyond their natural aptitudes and gives them the opportunity to become God's special instruments in this world.

WHAT ARE THE FRUITS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT?

The fruits of the Holy Spirit are charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity,

gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control and chastity. In the fruits of the Holy Spirit the world can see what becomes of people who let themselves be adopted, led and completely formed by God. The fruits of the Holy Spirit show that God really plays a role in the life of Christians.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO SAY: I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY SPIRIT?

It means to worship him as God just like the Father and the Son.

It means to believe that the Holy Spirit comes into our hearts so that we as children of God might know our Father in heaven. Moved by God's Spirit, we can change the face of the earth.

WHAT ROLE DOES THE HOLY SPIRIT PLAY IN THE LIFE OF JESUS?

Without the Holy Spirit, we cannot understand Jesus. In his life the presence of God's Spirit, whom we call the Holy Spirit, was manifest in a unique way. It was the Holy Spirit who called Jesus to life in the womb of the Virgin Mary (Matthew 1:18), endorsed him as God's beloved Son (Luke 4:16-19), guided him (Mark 1:12) and enlivened him to the end (John 19:20). On the Cross, Jesus breathed out his Spirit. After his Resurrection, he bestowed the Holy Spirit on his disciples (John 20:22). At that, the Spirit of Jesus went over to his Church: "As the Father has sent me, even so I send you" (John 20:21).

UNDER WHAT NAMES AND SIGNS DOES THE HOLY SPIRIT APPEAR?

The Holy Spirit descends upon Jesus in the form of a dove. The first Christians experience the Holy Spirit as a healing ointment, living water, a raging storm or a flaming fire. Jesus himself speaks about the Counselor, Comforter, Teacher and Spirit of Truth. In the sacraments of the Church, the Holy Spirit is bestowed through the imposition of hands and anointing with oil. The peace that God established in his covenant with mankind after the flood was indicated to Noah through the appearance of a dove. Pagan antiquity, too, considered the dove to be a symbol of love. And so the early Christians understood immediately why the Holy Spirit, the love of God in person, came down in the form of a dove when Jesus allowed himself to be baptized in the Jordan. Today the dove is recognized worldwide as the sign of peace and as one of the great symbols for the reconciliation of man with God.
