31ST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Children have such great expectations. They often show an eagerness that marvels adults. They can't wait to get at the Christmas gifts. They race off to explore new vistas. They dive into new things with an energy that seems beyond imagining. This exuberant curiosity that characterizes childhood gets channeled over time into an exploration of one's place in the world as teenagers or young adults discover their own selves and decide what they want to do with their lives. Sometimes, the intense eagerness of childhood is restrained by the reality of the adult world in which real limitations are made manifest. Not everything is a game to explore anymore.

In this Sunday's Gospel, we have a story of a man who had to face his own limitations. Zacchaeus was a short guy. He couldn't see above the crowd. But he used his own ingenuity in his attempt to see Jesus. He climbed up a sycamore tree and sat in its branches because he wanted to catch a glimpse of this prophet who had come to Jericho. Jesus in turn stops at the sycamore and invites Zacchaeus to come down. Whatever limitations Zacchaeus had because of his height, it didn't seem to affect his business acumen, for the Gospel tells us that he was a wealthy man. The people of Jericho seem to think that not all of his wealth was acquired legitimately. But Zacchaeus stands his ground, promising to over-compensate anyone whom he may have harmed.

As we move on in life, we may find ourselves at the point of having lost some of the enthusiasm for what got us to where we are. Our day-to-day experiences can sometimes feel like a rut that consumes our energy. The story of Zacchaeus reminds us that there can be a renewal of grace that enlivens us once again. We might consider where Jesus is walking by in our life, and if we have the eagerness to see him.



31. NEDJELJA KROZ GODINU

Isusu su prigovarali što se druži s kompromitiranim ljudima: "Dođe Sin Čovječji: jede i pije, a vi velite: 'Gle, izjelice i pijanice, prijatelja carinika!' (Lk7, 34) Takav jedan bio je carinik Zakej. Iako nije bio bolestan, može se reći da je u susretu s Isusom 'iscijeljen'. O kakvoj je bolesti riječ?

Zakej je bio 'izgubljen'. Njegovo bogatstvo stećeno je na nepošten način. Kao glavni carinik, visoki položaj je koristio za osobni probitak. Obogatio se na račun drugih. Zakej se klanja i služi novca. Zbog svega toga poobožni su ga ljudi u Jerihonu odbacili, otpisali. On je grješnik; netko koga se treba izbjegavati. I tako je Zakej živio u materijalnom blagostanju, ali izoliran od zajednice. Duboko u sebi sve je to potisnuo, ali ga je mučio taj osjećaj izdvojenosti.

Želi vidjeti Isusa. "Ali nije mogao od mnoštva naroda, jer je bio malog rasta. Zato potrči naprijed, uspe se na divlu smokvu da ga vidi, jer je tuda morao proći." Neobičan prizor: bogat čovjek uspije se na stablo kako bi video čovjeka koji prolazi gradom okružen mnoštvom. Isus vidi unutarnju potrebu čovjeka. "Zakeju, siđi žurno. Danas mi je boraviti u tvojoj kući." Isus u znatiželji Zakeja prepoznaće njegovu duboku nevolju.

"On siđe brzo te ga s veseljem primi u goste." Ne znamo o čemu se u kući razgovaralo. Poznat nam je samo ishod susreta. Zakej se ne želi više bogatiti na račun drugih ljudi. Spreman je svima nadoknaditi nanesenu štetu. Pohlepa više ne vlada njime. Slobodan je. Dijeli s drugima materijalne stvari. Prešao je iz smrti u život.

Isusova prisutnost i naklonost potakla ga je na obraćenje. Isus potvrđuje Zakejevo ozdravljenje: "Danas je došlo spasenje ovoj kući, jer je i on Abrahamov sin". Isus je došao potražiti ono što je izgubljeno. To je bio njegov životni program. Bog ne želi smrt grješnika, nego obraćenje i život.

Evanđelist Luka ističe dva motiva da ih zapazimo: žurba i radost. "Zakeju, siđi brzo...". I on mora žurno sići, kao što je nekoć Marija žurno pohitila Elizabeti ili kao što su pastiri na glas anđela požurili do jaslica. To je dinamika Duha Božjega koji potiče na hitnju. I sve se zbiva u ozračju radosti. Radost želi sve promijeniti. Kada se evanđelje primi otvorena srca, rađa se velika radost. I ta se radost zatim dijeli s drugima.

NOVEMBER 8TH - BL. JOHN DUNS SCOTUS

Beatified in 1993 by Bl. John Paul II, the Franciscans may celebrate the optional memorial of Blessed John Duns Scotus, a Scottish Franciscan priest and theologian who died in 1308. He was the founder of the Scotistic School in Theology, and until the time of the French Revolution his thought dominated the Roman Catholic faculties of theology in nearly all the major universities of Europe. He is chiefly known for his theology on the Absolute Kingship of Jesus Christ, the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and his philosophic refutation of evolution. He is also known as the "Doctor of Mary Immaculate" because of his defense of the Immaculate Conception.

Bl. John Duns Scotus was born in the winter of 1266 in the South of Scotland. Around 1279 he was accepted in a Franciscan friary in South Scotland. After eight years of preliminary studies in philosophy, or rather in the artes, at Oxford, he started to study theology there in 1288. Having attained the age of 25 he was ordained a priest in Northampton on March 17, 1291. In the academic year 1297-98 John prepared his first theological course which would change his life. During the next year he gave this course, on the *Sentences* of Peter Lombard, the most important textbook of systematic theology at the time. During these years (1297-99) John wrote *Lectura I-II*, his lecture notes on the two first books of the *Sentences*. Scotus' course based on these notes not only impressed his audience very much, but also the Franciscan leadership, and established his name as an exceptionally penetrating and original thinker.

In the summer of 1301 John had fulfilled all the requirements for being a master. However, he was sent to Paris to continue a Parisian career, at the most prestigious university of Europe.

After having again taught on the *Sentences* for a year, he and some of his colleagues were banished in June 1303 from Paris because of a conflict between the French king Philip IV and Pope Boniface VIII. He returned to his *studium* at Oxford and spent the first half of 1304 in Cambridge. At the end of the summer of 1304 he was already back in Paris where he became professor of theology in 1306. John and his *socius* continued to work very hard on his *Ordinatio* together with a staff of assis-

tants. In 1307 John leaves Paris again, but this time he left for Cologne in order to become the professor of theology at the Franciscan House of Studies. On November 8, 1308 he died suddenly in Cologne, leaving behind quite a number of unfinished works, including his *Ordinatio*.

8. STUDENOOGA - BL. IVAN DUNS SKOT

Blaženi Ivan Duns Scot, veliki škotski teolog i filozof, franjevac, nazvan "Doctor subtilis" (profinjeni, oštroumni naučitelj) rođio se oko 1265. u škotskom gradu Dunsu. Sin bogatog farmera, školovao se kod franjevaca u škotskom gradu Dumfriesu, a za svećenika je zaređen 1291. u engleskom gradu Northamptonu.

Glavni je predstavnik franjevačke skolastičke škole, studirao je u Oxfordu i Parizu, predavao u Oxfordu i Cambridgeu od 1297. do 1301, od 1302. godine naučavao i doktorirao u Parizu.

Jedan od najvećih srednjovjekovnih mislilaca, tvrdio je da se crkveno učenje ne može svesti u znanstveni sustav i da se vjerske dogme ne mogu logički dokazati. Isticao je sveopću nazočnost Isusa Krista i dokazivao prednost ljubavi nad znanjem. Vjerovanje nije po njemu čin uma, već odluka volje. U spoznajnoj teoriji polazio je od osjeta, vjerovao je da se tek intelektom dolazi do prave spoznaje. Po njemu je prvi iskovski Božji čin ljubav, Bog je u sebi bitno ljubav, a druga bića je stvorio ne nužno, nego zato što je htio s njima podijeliti u najvišem stupnju svoju ljubav. Premda jedan od vodećih skolastičara, začetnik skolastičkog smjera i škole, navijestio je novovjekovnu kritičku misao. Posljednja velika figura zlatnoga doba srednjovjekovne filozofije.

Glasovit je i po obrani i promicanju istine o bezgrešnom začeću BDM. Tvrđio je kako je Marijino začeće slobodno od istočnoga grijeha, po milosti Kristovoj, kojom je ona unaprijed očuvana od grijeha, zbog budućeg Bogomajčinstva. Preminuo je 8. studenoga 1308. u Kölnu. Papa bl. Ivan Pavao II proglašio ga je blaženim 1993, nazivajući ga "radosnim navjestiteljem utjelovljene Riječi i braniteljem Marijina bezgrešnog začeća".
