22ND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Although Jews, Christians, and Muslims share a monotheistic faith, that is, a belief in the oneness of God, there is much that is vastly different among the three religions. A common expression used by many Arab Muslims (which has already been subsumed into English) is inshallah a contraction of the Arabic words "in sha' Allah" meaning "if God wills it." The expression holds within itself the attitude that things will unfold because God permits them to happen. "We will see each other tomorrow, inshallah" that is, God willing. There is a kind of a sense of fate in this attitude. Human action is ultimately dependent on divine permission.

The Gospel today takes a different approach. Jesus instructs his disciples that whoever would follow after him must "take up his cross, and follow me." He continues, "For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. What profit would there be for one to gain the whole world and forfeit his life?" The disciple actively chooses the suffering that is part of human existence and seeks out the will of God in his or her life. By seeking first what is right (i.e., the will of God), the disciple finds true happiness, which eludes those who seek such happiness directly in trying to gain the whole world.

Christianity has always been an active religion. We believe that we cooperate with God's grace in performing God's will. Christians do not shrink from promoting the common good and moving forward as part of their faith. When we act in the social sphere we do so believing that God has placed us on this earth with a purpose, that each person must discern God's will in his or her own life. That gift of vocation, whatever it may be for each individual, is lived out in the community of faith for the building up of God's kingdom bear.



22. NEDJELJA KROZ GODINU

Onaj koji je nahranio mnoštvo, utišao oluju, ozdravljao - isti je onaj koji će mnogo trpjeti i biti predan u smrt. Isus je činio velika djela, koja su pokazivala da ima izvanrednu moć. Zašto ju nije upotrijebio u svoju vlastitu obranu? Moć i darovi dani su da bi se izgrađivalo kraljevstvo Božje, a ne za samouzdanje. Tko god želi slijediti Krista mora ići njegovim stopama, a to znači da ga mora slijediti do križa. Isusa se može slijediti ili ne slijediti: no onaj tko odluči slijediti ga mora biti spreman na trpljenje i poniženje. Mora odbaciti standarde svijeta. To nije lako, posebno kad se čovjeku čini da oni koji slijede standarde ovog svijeta prolaze bolje od onih koji slijede Božje standarde. Oni koji slijede Isusa mogu se suočiti s barijerama; jer ako ne dijele iste vrijednosti kao i ostali može doći do odbacivanja. Isusova poruka dovela je do antagonizma. Oni koji naviještaju istu poruku, moraju biti spremni na slične reakcije ljudi. Nakon silnih djela Isus će biti predan u smrt. Kako je to moguće? Vjernik može protestirati s Petrom ili se čuditi s Jeremijom: "Jesam li zaveden?" Odgovor je: ne, jer trpljenje i spasenje idu skupa.

Evangelje se sastoji od dva različita, ali povezana ulomka. Isus pretkazuje svoju muku, smrt i uskrsnuće, a nakon toga raspravlja o potrebi da ga učenici trebaju slijediti, prihvaćajući patnje i trpljenja. Oba ulomka oslanjanju se na Isusov govor o neminovnosti njegova trpljenja i muke koja će se dogoditi u Jeruzalemu. Isus izjavljuje da će biti odbaćen, trpjeti, umrijeti te uskrsnuti, izazvavši tako kod Petra veliku žalost. Takvo shvaćanje Mesije ne podudara se s očekivanjem ljudi. Ako se gleda ljudski, normalna je Petrova reakcija i briga za sudbinu učitelja. Isus ističe da je upravo tu problem: gledati samo iz ljudske perspektive, a ne iz Božje.

Okrećući se učenicima, Isus donosi još jednu lekciju o učeništvu. Oni koji ga žele slijediti, poput njega će morati odbaciti vlastite interese. Oni koji uzmu križ moraju shvatiti da je njihova sudbina zapečaćena, tj. da se križ jednom prigrljen ne skida s ramena. Slijedi igra riječima "spasiti" i "izgubiti". Oni koji žele izbjeći patnju križa neće izbjeći patnju pakla. A one koji prigrle križ Isus će zagrliti u kraljevstvu nebeskom. To znači slijediti Isusa.

Dear Father,

We all have been witnessing the ongoing tragedy and violence erupting in the Middle East. Millions in Iraq, Syria, and Gaza are continually displaced, murdered, and attacked, and the situation is increasingly becoming more violent. Archbishop Joseph E. Kurtz of Louisville, Kentucky, President of the U. S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, has now called on us to consider taking up a special collection "to provide humanitarian relief and pastoral support for our affected brothers and sisters in the Middle East."

Consequently, I am asking the faithful of the Archdiocese of Chicago to please pray for peace and contribute to the *Special Collection for the Middle East* on the weekend of *September 6-7* at your parish. The urgency for this emergency appeal is evident, as we must together show our "great concern for the ongoing crisis in the Middle East, the cradle of Christianity," as Archbishop Kurtz explained in the letter. "Our Church mourns the terrible suffering of Christians and other innocent victims of violence in Iraq, Syria and Gaza who are struggling to survive, protect their children and live with dignity in dire conditions."

Catholic Relief Services (CRS) and other Catholic agencies are working tirelessly to provide for the immediate humanitarian needs for the most vulnerable in need in these conflict areas in Iraq, Gaza, Syria and other surrounding countries. Monies received from this collection will go directly to aid persecuted Christians and other innocent victims and rebuild the needs of the Catholic dioceses in these areas.

To that end, I urge all of you to respond with generosity in both prayer and by providing monetary support for our brothers and sisters in this crisis situation. Please also continue to include these victims in your general intercessions during Mass. You and those whom God has called you to serve are in my prayers; please keep me in yours.
