
21ST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In the Gospel we have the account of Jesus giving authority to Simon Peter and acknowledging of his faith. We know that later Saint Peter will have his doubts and will even deny Jesus, but it looks fairly clear that no one - not even our Lord - held that against him or ever doubted his role in the early Church. The Church is built on Peter, not on his faith. Authority is a service in any community and should never be seen as domination. On the other hand, the person who has authority at times must exercise it in a way that leaves others unhappy.

Many people simply do not want any authority over them. The true authority in the Church is Christ himself, especially at the level of his teachings and of his giving us understanding of the word of Scripture. But there are always lots of practical decisions to be made in any community. We see these kinds of practical decisions already being made in the early Church, especially as it is present in the Acts of the Apostles, but also in the letters of Saint Paul.

Jesus gives authority not to put power in someone's hands, but because he clearly recognizes that any group needs someone in this role of service and servant of the community. We do not need to think of the early Church as fully formed in some sense, but rather as the beginnings of the Church. Even in our own times, the Church continues to adapt herself to times and places - but always with that incredible foundation in the teachings of Jesus Christ, in our faith in Jesus Christ. First reading, from the Prophet Isaiah, is surely given to us to help us understand the Gospel. The Lord is putting Eliakim into a position of responsibility, in charge of the household of David. This role of authority in a household is a clear parallel to the Church. David is the head of his household. Christ is the head of the Church. Eliakim can open and close in a completely authoritative manner. Peter has that role in the Church.

We Catholics believe that this role of St. Peter passes on to the Bishop of Rome, whom we call the Pope or the Holy Father. If such a position in the Church could exist even after the death of our Lord, there is no reason to think that it could not exist today and have been handed down.



21. NEDJELJA KROZ GODINU

Ispitivanje javnog mišljenja je kao kruh svagdanji javnim medijima. U redovitim razmacima propituju se mišljenja ljudi i njihove naklonosti. I u evanđelju se nalazi jedno propitanje mišljenja: Što misle ljudi tko je Sin čovječji? To je pitanje koje je važno postaviti. I odgovori nisu tako loši. Ljudi smatraju da je Isus neki veliki prorok. Prorok nije gatalac ili istražitelj budućnosti, nego Božji poslanik s jasnim pogledom na njegovu prisutnost i otvoreno uho i srce za Boga. Prorok je most koji povezuje ljude i Boga, netko tko ulijeva ljudima nadu i pokazuje nove mogućnosti i perspektive. Prorok je samo jedna od mnogih oznaka za Isusa. U cijelom Novom zavjetu nalazi se ravno 157 raznih imena, naziva, službi za Isusa: među njima su tako časni i uzvišeni nazivi kao Mesija, Sin Božji, Jaganjac Božji, Prorok, kao i negativni opisi: prozdrljivac, pjanica, neprijatelj carev, kršitelj zakona i slični.

Navedena su tri imena kao plod ispitivanja mišljenja: Isus je novi Ivan Krstitelj, Jeremija ili Ilija. Ivan je bio veliki pustinjski propovjednik i askeeta, preteča i pripravitelj puta za Isusa. Askeza, uzdržljivost i odlučnost je dobra, ali odricanje ne smije voditi odricanju od života. To je znao Isus, zato nije živio samo u molitvi i samoći, nego je išao i na pirove, bio gost u kućama ljudi gdje je jeo i pio. Ilija je bio veliki prorok, svim silama se borio za vjeru, čak i nasiljem. I nije se plašio uništiti svoje protivnike. Isus je isto tako trpio, no on nije uništavao, on je pridobivao. Iako je govorio jakim riječima, ipak ih je nastojao pridobiti za Kraljevstvo nebesko. Tu je spomenut i treći prorok – Jeremija, veliki prorok koji je trpio nutarnje i izvanske patnje. I Isus će trpjeti. No, patnja nije Isusov cilj, nego konačno, posljedica njegove ljubavi. Isus nije došao da ljudi trpe, nego da budu sretni i blaženi.

AUGUST 27 - ST. MONICA

The circumstances of St. Monica's life could have made her a nagging wife, a bitter daughter-in-law and a despairing parent, yet she did not give way to any of these temptations. Although she was a Christian, her parents gave her in marriage to a pagan, Patricius, who lived in her hometown of Tagaste in North Africa. Patricius had some redeeming features, but he had a violent temper and was licentious. Monica also had to bear with a cantankerous mother-in-law who lived in her home. Patricius criticized his wife because of her charity and piety, but always respected her. Monica's prayers and example finally won her husband and mother-in-law to Christianity. Her husband died in 371, one year after his baptism.

Monica had at least 3 children who survived infancy. The oldest, Augustine, is the most famous. At the time of his father's death, Augustine was 17 and a rhetoric student in Carthage. Monica was distressed to learn that her son had accepted the Manichean heresy and was living an immoral life. For a while, she refused to let him eat or sleep in her house. Then one night she had a vision that assured her Augustine would return to the faith. From that time on, she stayed close to her son, praying and fasting for him.

When he was 29, Augustine decided to go to Rome to teach rhetoric. Monica was determined to go along. One night he told his mother that he was going to the dock to say goodbye to a friend. Instead, he set sail for Rome. Monica was heartbroken when she learned of Augustine's trick, but she still followed him. She arrived in Rome only to find that he had left for Milan. Although travel was difficult, Monica pursued him to Milan.

In Milan, Augustine came under the influence of the bishop St. Ambrose, who also became Monica's spiritual director. Monica became a leader of the devout women in Milan as she had been in Tagaste.

She continued her prayers for Augustine during his years of instruction. At Easter, 387, St. Ambrose baptized Augustine. Soon after, they left for Africa. Although no one else was aware of it, Monica knew her life was near the end. She told Augustine, "Son, nothing in this world now affords me delight. I do not know what there is now left for me to do or why I am still here, all my hopes in this world being now fulfilled." She became ill shortly after and suffered severely for 9 days before her death.

Almost all we know about St. Monica is in the writings of St. Augustine, especially his *Confessions*.

27. KOLOVOZA - SV. MONIKA

Sv. Monika se rodila 332. godine u gradiću Tagasti u Africi. Roditelji su joj bili kršćani. Mlada se udala za poganova Patricija s kojim je imala troje djece. Suprug joj je bio grub, a što je za nju bilo još bolnije, i nevjeran. Monika je na njegove ispade bijesu odgovarala blagošću, dobrotom i strpljivošću čime ga je ne samo smirila već i privela kršćanskoj vjeri. U dobi od 40 godina ostala je udovica.

Njezin prvoroden sin Augustin pošao je krim putem, imao je nazakonitog sina i priklonio se krivovjernom maniheizmu. U silnoj brizi za njegovu dušu majka ga je pratila na njegovim putovanjima. Išla je za njim u Rim, Milano i Ostiju. Zahvaljujući susretu sa svetim, milanskim biskupom Ambrozijem i majčinim molitvama i suzama, do Augustina je počela dopirati Božja milost. Napustio je krivovjerje i u uskrsnjoj noći 387. godine Monika je doživjela sreću da je njezin sin Augustin, a s njim i njegov sin Adeodat primio sakrament Krštenja. Nakon nekog vremena Monika se sa sinom uputila natrag u domovinu Afriku, no čekajući brod u Ostiji nedaleko Rima, zahvatila ju je bolest te je onđe umrla i bila pokopana. Danas se njezine relikvije čuvaju u Rimu, u crkvi sina Augustina koji je postao velik i poznat svetac i naučitelj Katoličke crkve.

Zaštitnica je kršćanskih žena, udovica i majki i zagovornica za spas duša svoje djece.
