26TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

There is an old saying that the road to hell is paved with good intentions. Nothing is easier than failing to follow through on a promise and then expecting a free pass merely by saying "I intended to do that but just didn't get around to it!" Imagine those words coming from a pilot or a surgeon; in the eyes of God, every promise carries the same weight.

Today's Gospel from Matthew is a very short parable of two sons. These boys were the recipients of many gifts, including a loving father, a home, food, and a place to work - their father's vineyard. It was this vineyard and its crop that allowed these boys to have their gifts; yet when their father asked them to work in the vineyard, one said no (but later returned and did the work) and the other said yes (but never followed through on his promise). Such is how we live our lives - some eventually giving thanks for their gifts, others meaning to but never getting around to it.

The Catechism reminds us that we are called upon to make promises to God frequently in our lives; in baptism, weddings, confirmation, holy orders, we make promises. Just as Jesus Christ promised us everlasting peace in the arms of a loving God, our promise to "work in the vineyard" - to live our lives as a sign of gratitude for our many gifts must be kept. This is a sign not only of love for God but respect. So too must we keep our promises to each other, because the love and respect we show to others we show to God too. The road to heaven is paved with promises fulfilled!





26. NEDJELJA KROZ GODINU

Motiv dvojice braće i njihove različite reakcije predstavljaju središte današnje evanđeoske poruke. U mnogim biblijskim zgodama, u bajkama i romanima, kao i u kazališnim i filmskim obradama, nalazimo motiv dvojice braće. Prisjetimo se nekih: Kain koji ubija svoga brata Abela; Jakov preotima bratu Ezavu pravo na nasljedstvo i na prijevaru dobiva očev blagoslov; dvojica braće iz Lukine prispodobe o milosrdnom Ocu; Romul koji je uklonio svoga brata blizanca Rema kod utemeljenja grada Rima i mnogi drugi. U Isusovoj priči riječ je o čovjeku koji je imao dva sina i šalje ih na posao u vinograd. Prvi ocu odgovara: 'Neću!' No poslije se predomisli i ode. Drugi odgovori: 'Evo me!' i ne ode. U prisjećanju na djetinjstvo mnogi prepoznaju obrazac ponašanja dvojice sinova iz evanđelja: jedno dijete koje je poslušno i roditeljima uvijek odgovara 'da'; i drugo dijete koje je buntovno, prkosno, i odmah kaže 'ne'.

Ako pokušamo današnju evanđeosku zgodu vidjeti iz dubinsko-psihološkoga motrišta, tada dvojica sinova mogu predstavljati različite aspekte vlastitoga duševnog života, odnosno, upućuju na različite osjećaje i mogućnosti ponašanja u nama samima. Tako otkrivamo da zapravo obojicu braće nosimo u sebi: kako onoga koji pristojno kaže 'da', ali iza čijih riječi ne slijede djela; tako i onoga drugoga koji zlovoljno kaže 'ne', ali nakon što se malo pribrao i razmislio, ipak je poslušao svoga oca. Često u sebi nosimo 'dvije duše': u nama se bore licemjer i buntovnik. Ovaj obrazac – 'lijepa priča' ili 'djelotvorna i energična akcija' – prisutan je u mnogim područjima ljudske djelatnosti. Iz Isusovih je riječi sasvim razvidno da je Bogu draži onaj koji možda kaže da ne vjeruje a ipak čini dobro, od onoga koji se bučno kune u svoju vjeru a u životnoj praksi prezire ljubav i dobrotu. Često je veoma dug put koji vodi od 'reći ne' pa do toga da se osoba 'predomisli' i na koncu ispuni volju očevu osti.

BISHOP CUPICH NAMED TO SUCCEED CARDINAL GEORGE AS CHICAGO ARCHBISHOP

Pope Francis has appointed Bishop Blase J. Cupich of Spokane, Washington, as the 9th archbishop of Chicago. The appointment was announced Sept. 20 in Washington by Archbishop Carlo Maria Vigano, apostolic nuncio to the United States. Archbishop Cupich, 65, will be installed in Chicago Nov. 18 during a Mass at Holy Name Cathedral in Chicago.

Cardinal George introduced Archbishop Cupich during a news conference held at the Archbishop Quigley Pastoral Center in Chicago the day the appointment was announced.



"Bishop Cupich is well prepared for his new responsibilities and brings to them a deep faith, a quick intelligence, personal commitment and varied pastoral experiences," Cardinal George said.

The new archbishop is no stranger to Chicago having served on the board of Catholic Extension since 2009. The Chicago-based organization supports the work and ministries of U.S. mission dioceses.

Archbishop Cupich said his appointment "humbles and encourages" him and his priority as the new archbishop is to be attentive to the way God is working through the people in the archdiocese. He learned of the appointment 10 days before the announcement and said he felt overwhelmed and surprised when Archbishop Vigano called him. Some in the media describe Archbishop Cupich as a moderate but when asked about the description, he said, "Labels are hard for anybody to live up to, one way or another. I just try to be myself and I try to learn from great people. You've had great people here in this archdiocese pastor you. And I'm following a great man."

When asked if his appointment — the first major appointment made by Pope Francis in the United States — sends a message about the pontiff's agenda, Archbishop Cupich said no. "I think the Holy Father is a pastoral man. I think that his priority is to send a bishop, not a message," he said.

That Archbishop Cupich's new flock is a lot larger than his present flock is not lost on him. "This is an enormous upgrade, so to speak," Archbishop Cupich said. "We had a hundred thousand Catholics in eastern Washington and I had 27,000 Catholics in South Dakota." There are 2.2 million Catholics in the Archdiocese of Chicago, which is the third largest archdiocese in the nation.

When pressed on what tone he will bring to the archdiocese, the new archbishop said: "I think it's really important to keep in mind that it's not my church, it's Christ's church. I have to be attentive to his voice in the lives of the people and the word of God and the way that he communicates to all of us through the pointers that he gives."

Archbishop Cupich thanked Catholics in archdiocese for their warm welcome and said he looks forward to visiting parishes and communities. "I really am sincere in saying I know that I can only do this if I have their support and prayers. I want to be very pronounced in asking, begging for their prayers." Archbishop Cupich did his doctoral work on Scripture readings used in the liturgy and that remains a part of his spiritual nourishment, he said. "I find that, not just the word of God in the Bible, but the convergence of how the texts are put together in the liturgy is a source of my own spiritual life."

Born March 19, 1949, in Omaha, Nebraska, he is one of 9 children and the grandson of Croatian immigrants. He was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Omaha in 1975. He was named bishop of Rapid City, South Dakota, in 1998. In 2010, he was appointed to Spokane. He speaks Spanish and lives at the seminary there. He has degrees from what is now the University of St. Thomas in St. Paul, MN, the Pon-

tifical Gregorian University in Rome and The Catholic University of America in Washington. He served as secretary at the apostolic nunciature in Washington and was pastor of two parishes in Omaha. On the national level, he currently chairs the U.S. bishops' Subcommittee on Aid to the Church in Central and Eastern Europe and is former chair of the Committee for the Protection of Children and Young People.
