



21ST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

For many years, an organization held huge seminars around the country, bringing in motivational speakers to talk to salespeople from all areas of business. It was an all-day event, and crowds of 10,000 or more would fill arenas to hear the speakers. At the conclusion of the day, everyone was filled with a renewed spirit and zest for selling, having been taught many little lessons on how to be better. Unfortunately, many of those who attended the lectures didn't put into practice what they had heard, and had soon turned back to their old habits.

In this Sunday's Gospel reading, we hear some of the saddest words imaginable: "many (of) his disciples returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him." While Jesus knew that they would, how utterly devastated must he have felt? He even turned to his chosen Twelve, asking if they wanted to leave as well. Judas Iscariot did; Peter nearly did when the going got rough. But that is when we need to stand firm, shoulder to shoulder with Jesus, knowing he would never turn away from us.

Your child has fallen and scraped her knee; her first thought is to cry out your name. Who among us would turn away from his or her child in her time of need? Just as God does not turn away, he invites our cry to him by asking us to pray. We are sinners who as Christians know that we have turned away from our Father. Our prayer is already a turning back to him. When Jesus asks the Twelve Apostles if they, too, will leave him, Peter asks where else would they go, except to the one who has the words of eternal life. Where else would you turn?



21. NEDJELJA KROZ GODINU

Odluke na koje pozivaju današnja čitanja nisu odluke koje se donose svaki dan. Ne radi se o odlukama između nekoliko mogućnosti, koje su relativno iste važnosti, ili o beznačajnim odlukama. Radi se o životnim odlukama, o odlukama koje određuju temeljni put; radi se o odlukama koje će bitno određivati svaku drugu buduću odluku. Ljudi su u Jošuino vrijeme morali odlučiti kojeg će boga slijediti i štovati. Ta odluka će odrediti njihov identitet. Tom odlukom oni će se obvezati na norme i zakone koje im taj bog odredi. Danas izaberite i odlučite kome ćete služiti!

I Isusovi učenici morali su donijeti sličnu odluku. Mnoga Isusova djela i riječi dovodila su ljudе do nevjericе. Ono što najviše začduje jest čijenica da nevjerovanje ne dolazi od Isusovih protivnika, nego od njegovih najbližih učenika. Oni su bili više nego šokirani; moglo bi se reći da su se sablaznili na ono što je Isus rekao. Ono što im je govorio o sebi, bilo je za njih previše. Naime, Isus je ovdje govorio o sebi kao Sinu Božjem koji je sišao s neba. I umjesto da omeša svoj govor, da bude razumljiviji i prihvatljiviji, Isus tim nevjernicima odgovara na njemu svojstven način. Ako nisu mogli prihvati i povjerovati da je on sišao s neba, što će tek misliti o njemu kada bude uzlazio na nebo i odlazio tamo odakle je i došao? I silazak i uzlazak na nebo uključuju ideju da je on nebesko biće - tvrdnja koja je prvotno šokirala njegove učenike. Isus ne kaže da će oni biti svjedoci njegova uzlaska, nego ih jednostavno pita kako će se poнаšati ako to vide. Hoće li taj događaj proizvesti u njima vjeru? Hoće li njihovo neshvaćanje biti razlogom njihova odlaska? Jedni odlaze, drugi pak ostaju uz Isusa.

THE MOST IMPORTANT LEADERSHIP ROLE WE'RE NOT TALKING ABOUT

Husbands and wives. Fathers and mothers. Breadwinners and homemakers. There are a number of different titles given to a man and woman who come together to raise a family. But do most couples consider themselves to be leaders of their families?

My husband and I didn't begin our family with a clear understanding of our roles as spiritual leaders. A conversation on the way home from Mass a few months after our first son was born led my husband to confess, "I want to be a strong spiritual head of our family, Katie, but I don't know how." So we began looking for practical tools and resources to help both of us see what spiritual leadership looked like in family life.

Spiritual leadership of the family is not one job among many, but arguably the most crucial vocation men and women are called to when they enter into the adventure and lifelong commitment of family life. Yet many men and women are drastically underprepared to be the spiritual head of the family or the spiritual heart of the family that God calls them to be.

Within the family, both the man and the woman, the head and the heart, channel their complementary masculinity and femininity toward the supreme privilege and responsibility of cooperating with God's grace and using the gifts, talents, and tools he has given them to help lead every person in their family to heaven, becoming Saints—the title given to those who become the persons that God created them to be.

Spiritual leadership may or may not come naturally in family life. Most couples have to work for it. The harder they work and the more intentional they are at living out their distinct and complementary roles as the spiritual heads and hearts of their homes, the closer each member of the family and the family as a whole inches toward sanctity.

What if men and women began to understand more fully and take more seriously their roles as spiritual leaders in the home? What if husband and wives in the Church had a better understanding of their mutual complementarity, and how that complementarity uniquely qualified them to lead each other and any children in their care toward heaven? What if men and women were prepared to better lead their families spiritually before they entered into the Sacrament of Matrimony? What if husbands and wives in the thick of family life could be given tools and resources to help them improve their spiritual leadership, regardless of how long they've been at it or how advanced they may be in their spiritual lives?



I think answering these deep needs in family life today would be a game-changer for Catholic families and for the communities they live in and the Church they belong to. Answering these questions in our own marriage and family has already started a drastic transformation in my home. It's about time we, as individual men and women, and we, as a Church, discuss the most important leadership roles we're not talking about.
