THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

We have a special feast of Epiphany to celebrate the visit of the magi. Why is that? It is because the visit of the magi is an eye-opener. The shepherds learnt of the birth of Jesus through a direct revelation from angels appearing in the midnight sky. This is direct and supernatural revelation. Many of us have no problem with that. The magi, on the other hand, learnt of the birth of Jesus by observing a star. The star did not say anything to them. They had to interpret this natural sign of the star to know what it meant and where it led. If we remember that the magi or the three wise men were nature worshippers, people who divined God's will by reading the movements of the stars and other heavenly bodies, then we can see how the visit of the magi challenges some of our popular beliefs.

People of different situations came to know that the Son of God was born. The shepherds who were regarded as unclean and could not take part in Temple worship without undergoing purification came to know through a direct vision of angels. The magi knew through a reading of the stars. And King Herod's scribes came to know through searching the scriptures. Visions, stars, scriptures - different ways of arriving to the truth. Of course this does not mean that any religious tradition is just as good as the other. Notice how Matthew indicates that when the guiding star got to Jerusalem its light failed and the magi had to consult the scriptures to direct them to Bethlehem. Over and above the natural light of the star the magi still needed the supernatural light of scripture to finally get to Jesus.

Yet the crucial question remains: Who actually got to find Jesus? Herod and his scribes who had the scriptures failed to find Jesus but the magi who followed the natural light of the stars were able to find him. Why? Because the Jewish authorities, even though they possessed the shining truth of revealed scriptures, did not follow it. They did not walk in the light of the scriptures. The magi, on the other hand, who enjoyed only a star light, followed its guidance. It is not the possession of the truth that matters, it is how prepared we are to walk in the light of the truth that we possess.

BOGOJAVLJENJE - SVETA TRI KRALJA

On je kralj koji nema svečanih primanja, on je skriven, gotovo stavljen u stranu. A ipak je njegovo rođenje navijestila zvijezda te dovela mudrace s Istoka s darovima, da mu se poklone. Oni su tu ne radi sebe, već da svrate pažnju na novorođenoga Kralja, koga i oni naviještaju. On se objavljuje kao obećani Mesija, Spasitelj svih naroda. On se i danas kao Bog, čovjek i Spasitelj, želi objaviti svakome narodu i svakome pojedinome čovjeku preko svoje poruke u Evanđelju, želi se objaviti i preko nas kršćana, ali to će biti moguće samo u tolikoj mjeri uolikoj smo prihvatili njegovu poruku i koliko je proživljavamo. Naša pomoć njegovu objavljenu bit će i naš najbolji dar koji mu možemo dati.

Uoči Bogojavljenja običava se blagosloviti voda kojom se onda škrope ljudi, predmeti i prostori prigodom blagoslova. I naše obitelji svojim životom morale bi objavljivati Krista. Blagoslov kuća morao bi biti vanjski znak da će se u obitelji živjeti kršćanskim, to jest Kristovim životom, po načelima Evanđelja. Raspelo na vidnom mjestu u stanu morali bi na vanjski način pokazivati kome obitelj pripada i tko je njezin Gospodar i Učitelj.

Mudrace s Istoka, o kojima govori sv. Matej, ne spominjući im ni imena ni broja, kasnija je predaja pretvorila u kraljeve dajući im i imena: Gašpar, Melkior i Baltazar. Poslije smrti tih triju kraljeva njihove relikvije su bile donesene u Carigrad, a odande u Milano, odakle su 1164. godine prenesene u Köln. Nad tim je relikvijama podignuta veličanstvena katedrala koja je još i danas najveći ures grada Kölna, u kojem se veoma razvilo njihovo štovanje.

NEW YEAR - NEW BEGINNINGS FOR THE CHRISTIAN STEWARD

The start of a New Year gives us the feeling of a fresh start, a new beginning, and new opportunities. It is a time when people feel that they can begin anew with their lives. Common New Year's resolutions are to lose weight, exercise more and eat healthier; or to spend more time with family. Still others include managing money better and being more organized.

Although there is nothing in the Bible or notable in Christian tradition about New Year's resolutions, many good stewards take advantage of this time of year to become closer to the Lord. They may recommit themselves to pray more, to read the Bible, or to attend Mass more regularly. If you are looking for some helps in your New Year's resolutions, here are a few ideas to get you started:

- **Practice gratitude** – Cultivating a grateful heart is the hallmark of a Christian steward. Every day, express thankfulness to the Lord and to others. Seeing the good in your life will allow you to keep your heart compassionate and loving.



- **Encounter the Lord each day** – Find time to be with the Lord each day, whether it be for an hour or ten minutes. Have a conversation with the Lord. Give your joys and worries to Him as well. Allow God's love to transform them. Our encounters will keep our eyes and ears open to the presence of Christ in our midst.

- **Be present to others** – There is much celebration and mourning, joy and sorrow in peoples' lives. What a blessing it is to be able to share those times and not let others experience them alone. The gift of your presence to others is much more valuable than you realize.

- **Resist overwork** – There is a pressure to produce, meet goals, be successful. But activities that lead us to overwork, constant fatigue and worry do not give glory to God. What God calls us to do we can do well. Be mindful that life requires balance, down time and letting go of unrealistic goals.

- **Nurture friendships** – Our friends are those we choose to be with, those with whom we spend our evenings, with whom we vacation, to whom we go to for advice. Friends are gifts from God who give us a greater appreciation of God's love for us. Friends need our time and love.



- **Give more** – Good stewards realize that everything they have is entrusted to them as gift to be shared. There is no better place to begin than sharing with the community that gathers around the Lord's table at Mass. Consider what you are giving to your parish and local diocese and commit to an even greater contribution as circumstances allow.

- **Make a difference in your parish community** – Believe it or not, your parish community can use your talents. Offering your talents to your faith community is one of the most effective ways to feel useful and connected to others, and it is a potentially life-changing New Year's resolution.

- **Consider living more simply** – We cannot find fulfillment in possessions. They add nothing to our self-worth. Jesus blessed the "poor in spirit" in his Sermon on the Mount; and Saint Francis of Assisi urged us to live with only what was necessary, for that is how we begin to find God.

- **Get healthy** – Studies show that most people in North America are accelerating their own decline into premature old age, owing to poor diet and lack of physical activity. Be a good steward of your body. Plan a complete overhaul of your diet and exercise habits.

- **Don't give up** – People give up their New Year's resolutions because of perfectionism and unrealistic expectations. So take it slow, be kind to yourself and keep trying. Resist the urge to throw your hands up and quit. You succeed through small, manageable changes over time.

- **Turn to the Lord** – Ask the Lord for guidance, strength and perseverance in achieving your resolutions. In his letter to the Phillipians, Saint Paul writes: "I can do everything through Him who gives me strength" (Phil 4:13). If God is the center of our New Year's resolutions, they have a better chance for success.
