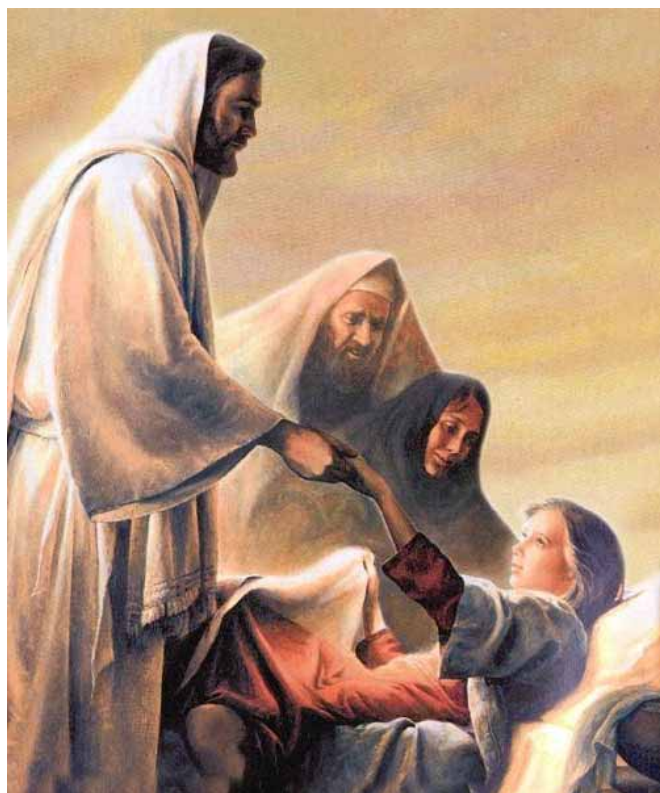

13TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The 19th century writer George Iles described hope as faith's hand outstretched in the dark. The scene is repeated thousands of time each day across the country; a man or a woman, any race, any age, any background, reaches out their hand and for the first time turns the doorknob to the meeting room in the church or the veteran's hall or the hospital. They are alcoholics or addicts, and have reached their own personal low. But as faith is always present, even in their darkest hour these men and women have found a slight glimmer of hope. Though the world has said, "Give up!" hope has said, "Try once more."

This Sunday's Gospel reading from Mark is really two stories, one within the other, of hope and faith. Jairus, a leader in the synagogue, begs Jesus to save his dying daughter. What Jairus doesn't know is that his daughter has already died; Jesus takes the man home. As they arrive, the crowd tells them the daughter is dead and begs Jesus to leave as it is hopeless. Jairus, however, still has hope in the healing power of Christ, and because of this the daughter is awakened. The other story takes place as Jesus walks to Jairus' home; an ailing woman in the crowd silently reaches out to touch Jesus' robe. He senses her faith without words, and heals her. He rewards her hope.

We seek happiness in our lives through the virtue of hope placed by God in all of our hearts. Hope keeps us from discouragement in tough times, it keeps us company when we are alone, and it keeps us in a state of reminder of all of God's beauty in creation. It is never too dark to reach out your own hand of faith and hope; another is reaching out to you with faith and hope as well.



13. NEDJELJA KROZ GODINU

Trinaesta nedjelja kroz crkvenu godinu nam govori o temi smrti i života. Odmah u prvom čitanju iz Knjige mudrosti nam biva jasno da Bog nije stvorio smrt nego je ona ušla u optjecaj đavlovom zavišću. Potrebno je razlučiti tjelesnu od duhovne smrti. Potrebno je uočiti da možemo tjelesno biti živi, a duhovno mrtvi. Potrebno je uvidjeti prema kojim smo vrednotama usmjereni, što nas to vodi u životu ili tko nas to vodi kroz život.

Popularna kultura nam nameće ideal lažne besmrtnosti i neuvjerljivo nas gura u iluziju kako ćemo na ovoj zemlji živjeti vječno. Kršćanstvo nam nudi drukčiju opciju gledanja na život po kojoj nam naznačava da smo prolazni, ali da nije sav čovjek prolazan nego da u nama postoji prolazni i neprolazni dio. Potrebno je vezati se za neprolazni dio i neprolazni dio vezati za Boga. Tada nam prolazni dio neće biti ubitačan i tada ćemo moći i smrt i bolest doživljavati relativno opušteno, na temelju iskustava mnogih istinskih vjernika.

I s druge strane, u onima koji nemaju dostatno vjere vidi se muka što prelaze u nepoznato, a nisu se dovoljno dobro pripravili za to. Zato je potrebno uvidjeti da Isus ima moć i nad smrću umrlih pa ih može čudesno oživljavati, kao što je bio slučaj Jairove kćeri koja je bila mlada i bolesna i onda se njezin otac zauzeo da je Isus ozdravi. U međuvremenu su javili da je djevojčica umrla. Međutim, Isus se ne da zaustaviti i hrabri Jaira riječima: "Ne boj se, samo vjeruj. Ono što je ljudima nemoguće, Bogu je moguće." Isus je ušao u sobu u kojoj je već bila mrtva Jairova kći, uzeo je za ruke i pozvao u život. To je bio znak da je Isus gospodar, da nema toga što neće učiniti za nas, ali potrebna je naša suradnja.

Vjera je most po kojem se Bog spušta k nama da nam podari kraljevstvo nebesko, mir, radost, ljubav.

PONAŠANJE U CRKVI

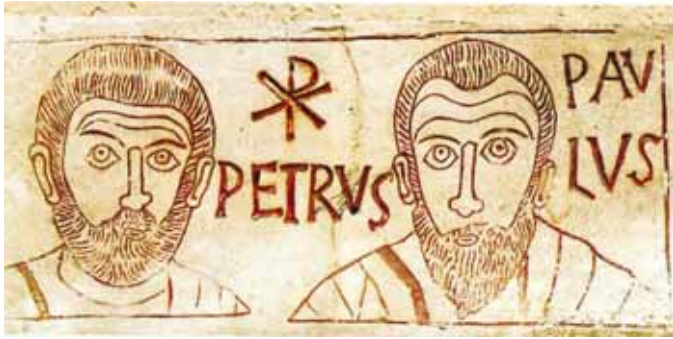

JUNE 29 - STS. PETER AND PAUL

As early as the year 258, there is evidence of an already lengthy tradition of celebrating the solemnities of both St. Peter and St. Paul on the same day. Together, the two saints are the founders of the See of Rome, through their preaching, ministry and martyrdom there.

Peter, who was named Simon, was a fisherman of Galilee and was introduced to the Lord Jesus by his brother Andrew, also a fisherman. Jesus gave him the name Cephas (Petrus in Latin), which means 'Rock,' because he was to become the rock upon which Christ would build His Church. Peter was a bold follower of the Lord. He was the first to recognize that Jesus was "the Messiah, the Son of the living God," and eagerly pledged his fidelity until death. In his boldness, he also made many mistakes, however, such as losing faith when walking on water with Christ and betraying the Lord on the night of His passion. Yet despite his human weaknesses, Peter was chosen to shepherd God's flock. The Acts of the Apostles illustrates his role as head of the Church after the Resurrection and Ascension of Christ. Peter led the Apostles as the first Pope and ensured that the disciples kept the true faith. St. Peter spent his last years in Rome, leading the Church through persecution and eventually being martyred in the year 64. He was crucified upside-down at his own request, because he claimed he was not worthy to die as his Lord. He was buried on Vatican hill, and St. Peter's Basilica is built over his tomb.

St. Paul was the Apostle of the Gentiles. His letters are included in the writings of the New Testament, and through them we learn much about his life and the faith of the early Church. Before receiving the name Paul, he was Saul, a Jewish pharisee who zealously persecuted Christians in Je-

rusalem. Scripture records that Saul was present at the martyrdom of St. Stephen. Saul's conversion took place as he was on his way to Damascus to persecute the Christian community there. As he was traveling along the road, he was suddenly surrounded by a great light from heaven. He was blinded and fell off his horse. He then heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?" He answered: "Who are you, Lord?" Christ said: "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting." Saul continued to Damascus, where he was baptized and his sight was restored. He took the name Paul and spent the remainder of his life preaching the Gospel tirelessly to the Gentiles of the Mediterranean world. Paul was imprisoned and taken to Rome, where he was beheaded in the year 67. He is buried in Rome in the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls.

In a sermon in the year 395, St. Augustine of Hippo said of Sts. Peter and Paul: "Both apostles share the same feast day, for these two were one; and even though they suffered on different days, they were as one. Peter went first, and Paul followed. And so we celebrate this day made holy for us by the apostles' blood. Let us embrace what they believed, their life, their labors, their sufferings, their preaching, and their confession of faith."
