6TH SUNDAY OF EASTER

It was 1943, and Hitler's legions of death squads had occupied most of Poland. In the small town of Nowogrodek, sixty Jews were executed. Soon, however, the Gestapo arrested another 120 citizens to be executed simply as a show of force. A small order of nuns, the Sisters of the Holy Family of Nazareth, offered themselves in exchange for the release of the 120 prisoners. The Nazis agreed, and on July 18th, eleven sisters were lead out into the woods and were murdered. Today, a biala fara (white church) stands at the final resting place of the blessed martyrs who gave their lives without hesitation for their friends.

Perhaps it is difficult to comprehend what it would feel like to willingly lay down one's life for a friend. In today's Gospel reading from John, we are given the answer through what is known as the Great Commandment - love. Jesus tells us that there is no greater love than to be willing to make the ultimate sacrifice for another. This is exemplified in God's pure, unending love for us in offering his only Son to die for our sins and give us everlasting life. If we are able to love one another purely and wholly as he loved us, all things will be possible, even our ultimate sacrifice for another.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church is very clear in explaining Jesus' words to us that if we are to love one another "as I have loved you" we cannot do it simply through words of promise or imitation. Only through the strength of the Holy Spirit will we be empowered to demonstrate, from the bottom of our heart, true love, mercy, and forgiveness. In the words of St. Ignatius of Loyola, "Teach us, good Lord, to serve you as you deserve, to give and not to count the cost.".



6. USKRSNA NEDJELJA

Kroz današnja čitanja provlači se tema ljubavi. Govor je o bezgraničnoj Božjoj ljubavi koja se najbolje očituje u tome da nas je Bog ljubio i prije nego smo zasluzili da budemo ljubljeni. Božja ljubav je ta koja je sposobila ljudi da mogu primiti ali i darivati ljubav. Ljubav je od Boga; ljubav je Bog. Te riječi lako izgovaramo; no puno je teže istinski razumjeti što one znače. Čak i najuzvišenija ljudska ljubav ima granice preko kojih teško prelazi. Svaki čovjek je toga svjestan. Ljudski govor o ljubavi može biti i apstraktan, a i "izlizan"; i ljudska ljubav se često svodi na ono što ljubav uopće nije. Ljubav mora imati svoje utemeljenje u Bogu. Ako čovjek prihvati istinsku ljubav, ona ga mijenja. Čovjek počinje uočavati Božju ljubav u stvarima i mjestima za koja nikad nije ni pomicao da je može naći.

I ulomak Ivanova evanđelja govori o ljubavi, i on je ustvari jedan od najpoznatijih ulomaka o ljubavi. Kad govori o ljubavi, pisac ne upotrebljava riječ eros koja uključuje neku vrstu posjedovanja, niti philia koja označava ljubav među rođinom. On koristi riječ agape. To je jedina riječ kojom se opisuje ljubav prema Bogu, a koja u sebi nosi i dimenziju ljubavi prema bližnjima. Riječ se pojavljuje 9 puta u tom ulomku i na lijep način povezuje ljubav koju Bog ima prema Isusu; ljubav Isusovu prema svojim prijateljima; kao i ljubav prijatelja međusobno. Isus poziva učenike da ostanu u ljubavi. Ne radi se o nečem prolaznom, nego se radi o trajnom ostajanju. Ono će se ostvariti kroz poslušnost. Sam Isus je primjer. Kao što je on bio poslušan Božjim zapovijedima, tako i učenici moraju biti poslušni njegovim zapovijedima. Ustvari, kroz poslušnost Kristu, učenici će biti poslušni Bogu. Ljubav o kojoj se govori je aktivna ljubav, ljubav koja dopire do drugih: Bog prema Isusu, Isus prema svojim učenicima, učenici jedni prema drugima. No ta ljubav ne smije tu stati. Aktivna ljubav mora ići i preko ovih granica.

TWO HEAVENLY MOTHERS

BY CATHOLIC MOM

The month of May is special because we honor our Blessed Mother. I don't think it's a coincidence we celebrate Mother's Day this month, too. It makes sense that we honor our earthly mother along with our heavenly mother at the same time.



For as long as I can remember, my mom told me to pray rosary. "At least one decade," she would plead with me. "Sure thing," I snarled, annoyed at the thought of repeating 10 Hail Marys, let alone 50. What I failed to realize was that I wasn't supposed to just "recite" the rosary; I was supposed to "pray" it. Guess I never heard the word "pray" come out of mother's mouth. And to be honest, I always felt like I was disobeyed my mother by not praying the rosary!

But the seed was planted. The rosary seemed to be my mother's "security blanket." As she got older, she was in and out of the hospital. Each time, my first question would be, "Does mom have her rosary with her?" If not, I would bring it to her.

I didn't view my mom's devotion as admirable, but I didn't see it as silly, either. It just was. But I could never figure out why she had so many rosaries. She could only pray with one at a time!

Over time, mom would keep encouraging me to pray the rosary. But it wasn't until I left Michigan and moved to Texas in my late 40s that I finally heeded that advice with some help from a religious sister at my church. Sister was another great influence on me, with her devout faith that included praying the rosary daily. She taught me to meditate on the mysteries through Mary's eyes.

Oh, so that's what Mom meant! I get it now.

I had to start slowly; praying all 5 decades at once wasn't easy for me. So, I began praying 1 or 2 decades in the morning, one or two during lunch, and finish up in the evening. I found it easier too, if I prayed with EWTN, a Catholic TV station. I wasn't praying it perfectly, but I was praying. I can only imagine the smile Our Lady had because I was at least trying

and gave up making excuses. I know my earthly mom was proud: I still remember calling her and telling her I was praying the rosary. I could hear her beaming over the phone lines, she was so excited.

I try to pray the rosary every day. I find it peaceful and relaxing. Praying scriptural rosary has given me a whole new insight into our Lord's life, which gives me insight into my own trials. When I follow along with a CD in my car, I find myself being a better driver, too. One of the many beauties of the rosary is I can pray it any time, any where, even in a long line at the grocery store.

Over the past few years I've built quite a collection of rosaries myself. They're by my bed, in my bathrobe pocket, purse, and car. Guess mom's collection wasn't so silly after all.

Sadly, in February, my mother passed away. She requested a closed casket, so when my husband and I made the trip to Michigan for the funeral, we went straight to the funeral home so I could have my proper goodbye. I put my hand on top of hers and thanked her for teaching me to pray the rosary. I then prayed the Hail Mary with her. I just know she was praying with me. About two months after she died, I had a wonderful dream. I dreamt mom and I were praying the rosary together. I felt so much at peace when I woke up from the dream.

I thought Mother's Day would be hard for me this year. And to some degree, it was. But I'm so blessed knowing I have two mothers looking after me from heaven: my earthly mom and Mother Mary. Now that's a true blessing.
