24TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

It is not uncommon, when talking to a friend about all of the challenges we are facing in our day-to-day lives, to have that friend tell us, "We all have our crosses to bear." It seems, however, that linking the symbol of the world's greatest sacrifice to a pile of past-due bills on the table is rather simplistic and misses the point of bearing our own cross. What are our real challenges, anyway? Is it harder to navigate this life's worldly difficulties, or to proclaim proudly our undying love of Jesus Christ to any and all who will listen?

Today's Gospel reading offers the memorable question from Jesus to his disciples, "Who do people say that I am?" Their answers are varied, but his follow-up question is more important: "But who do you say that I am?" They have had the opportunity to be closest to him, witness his miracles and enjoy his private teachings. And it is at this point that Jesus offers them yet another insight into everlasting life: "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me." The cross he is referring to is our willingness never to deny him as the one true savior, even if it means giving our lives in his name.

The cross is the unique sacrifice of Christ, the 'one mediator between God and men.' In telling his disciples - and us - that in order to follow him we must take up our own crosses, we are offered the possibility of being made partners in the paschal mystery. In a way, when a friend offers that "we all have our crosses to bear," as followers of Jesus we can be assured that yes, but it is only one, and it really isn't very heavy at all!

23. NEDJELJA KROZ GODINU

Mnogi očekuju Mesiju: jedni njegov prvi pojavak, drugi njegov konačni slavni povratak. Što mi očekujemo? Proročki lik koji će ući u naš svijet i obnoviti društvenu strukturu ili vladara koji će te strukture uništiti i uspostaviti novi poredak? Očekujemo li učitelja koji će preoblikovati naše misli i srca ili suca koji će nas kazniti zbog nevjernosti? Očekujemo li nekoga tko će doći i obnoviti lice zemlje ili nekoga tko će doći s vatrom i sve razoriti? Kakvog Mesiju mi očekujemo? Na kakvu vrstu promjene se pripremamo? Od očekivanja ovisi i naše djelovanje.

Čini se da Isus ruši naša očekivanja. Ljudi očekuju nekoga tko će ih izbaviti iz nevolja, a dolazi Isus koji je i sam žrtva patnjâ i nevoljâ. Nije čudo da ljudi misle da se radi o pogrešci. Čak je i Petar smatrao da mora postojati drugi način. No Isus ga je morao ispraviti i naglasiti da ne misli božanski, nego ljudski. A kako to Bog razmišlja? Čini se potpuno drugačije od ljudi: oni koji spašavaju svoj život, gube ga; oni koji izgube svoj život, ti će ga spasiti; sjeme mora umrijeti da bi donijelo ploda. To je Božji način razmišljanja.

LOVE IS OUR MISSION: THE FAMILY FULLY ALIVE

The World Meeting of Families in Philadelphia aims to lead families to know their importance as a gift from God and to help them open their hearts to Jesus Christ. The family “is the place where we feel most loved, most protected, most safe, valued,” said Fr. William Donovan, one of the meeting’s main organizers. “In the natural economy of things, one could say after the gift of life itself, the second greatest gift God has given us is family. The reason is because, once God gives us life, he also wants us to have a full life. He wants us to be loved, to be protected, to be safe, to be secure, to be valued.”

This year's World Meeting of Families will take place from September 22-27 with the theme “Love is Our Mission: The Family Fully Alive.” Its closing Mass with Pope Francis will mark the end of his first visit to the United States. The meeting also includes presentations, testimonies, and other events. “The idea is that we want to try to bring as many resources and assistance to the human family so that they can understand and execute its role as a place of love,” said Fr. Donovan.

Pope St. John Paul II founded the international event in 1994 to encourage families and to strengthen familial bonds. The event takes place every 3 years in a different city around the world. The event is a celebration of the importance, the nature, the dignity, and the beauty of the family.

One of the tasks involved in promoting the World Meeting of Families was in spreading awareness. Although the event has been taking place for more than 20 years, many Americans were unaware of it. “Of course, with the Holy Father’s coming, and that brings a great attention to it,” Fr. Donovan said.

Observing the particular care which Pope Francis has shown to the family since the beginning of his papacy, Fr. Donovan recalled in particular the image of the family being the first school, the first Church, and – especially – the first hospital. “This

image is particularly captivating because when we talk about the families as being the first hospital, we talked about wounds, or weakness,” he said. “The Holy Father is interested in attending particularly to the wounds and weaknesses of the human family.”

The weeklong World Meeting of Families will be divided into three parts: an international congress from September 22-25, consisting of presentations by experts on the family; an artistic festival with Pope Francis, which will include testimonies by one family from each continent; and finally, outdoor Mass on Sunday in Philadelphia's Benjamin Franklin Parkway. “Perhaps one can say that the human mind is nourished by the Congress, the human heart will be nurtured by the cultural celebration and the spirit will be nurtured by the Mass,” Fr. Donovan said.

Meeting organizers wanted the selection of speakers to showcase both the uniqueness of individuals and the shared experience which being part of a family brings. “Just like each person is a unique gift of God -- but there is something common in the human experience that we can all share about the dignity of a human person -- the same thing is with the family,” he said. Organizers wanted the speakers to convey how “every family is a unique and irreproducible gift of God, but there’s something common to all families.”

Any man and woman of goodwill, both from within and outside the Church, can participate in the importance and the dignity of the family. However, the primary aim of the organizers is to lead families closer to Christ. It would be wonderful if each person can take away something that makes him or her a better person, and improves their family: opening their minds and hearts to Christ will improve themselves and their families. This is our hope: to bring greater happiness, greater peace, greater security, and salvation, to our families. This year's World Meeting of Families will be the 8th of its kind, and the first to take place in the United States. The last World Meeting of Families was held in Milan in 2012.
