## 26<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Envy and jealousy are emotions we're all familiar with; they seem to appear with ease and yet are almost impossible to suppress or destroy. A coworker receives a promotion, and perhaps we wonder why it wasn't us. A neighbor announces she is building a new house, and suddenly our house is showing its age. A friend finds time to volunteer at a homeless shelter and participates in several ministries at your parish, all the while smiling about his life, and you wonder how negative his home life must be. Yet when you are blessed with good fortune by God, aren't you ready to shout it from the rooftops?

In today's Gospel reading, the disciples of Jesus have witnessed someone casting out demons in the name of Christ. Yet, as they point out, this person hasn't spent the time they have, following closely in the company of Jesus and listening to his teachings. Surely he can't be qualified, they say. Jesus gently reminds his disciples that any person who attempts to do truly good things in his name is a child of God. Perhaps the disciples were a bit envious; perhaps they failed to recognize that the abilities of this person were gifts from God, and in attempting to stop him they were attempting to deny God's wisdom in granting such gifts.

Jesus tells us the second greatest commandment, after loving God with all our hearts, is to love our neighbors as ourselves. The tenth commandment serves to instill in us the desire to abolish envy and jealousy completely. If we are willing to acknowledge that everything we have and are is a gift of God, we cannot afford to challenge God's wisdom in his gifts to others.

## 26. NEDJELJA KROZ GODINU

Kroz današnja čitanja provlači se tema tko ima pravo služiti u Božje ime. Daju se dva različita, ali ipak povezana odgovora.

Kao prvo, to pravo imaju oni koje je zajednica ovlasila. Radi se o tome da je crkvena zajednica, tj. crkvena vlast ona koja nekome daje vlast obavljati službene liturgijske čine. Tu je ovlast Isus dao svojim nasljednicima ističući da mogu vezati i odrješivati. No, postavlja se pitanje jesu li svi služitelji kompetentni; jesu li dovoljno sposobni i truda li se dovoljno da ispune zadaću koja se od njih očekuje i koja im je povjerena.

S druge strane, ima onih koji su sposobniji, ali nemaju ovlaštenja. Čitanja govore i o onima koji mogu služiti a koje je Duh odredio. Duh nije ograničen ljudskim strukturama i običajima. On je na dan Pedesetnice sišao na sinove i kćeri, staro i mlado, robove i slobodne. Čini se da je uvijek bilo određenih tenzija u Crkvi između institucionalnog i karizmatiskog. Bog uglavnom službenike poziva kroz strukture zajednice; no poziva i na druge načine. A kad Bog poziva, Crkva bi trebala prepoznati taj poziv. Temeljni kriterij prepoznavanja su plodovi.

## POPE FRANCIS DECLARES: JUNIPERO SERRA IS A SAINT

Celebrating his first Mass in the US on Wednesday, September 23, Pope Francis declared a new saint of the United States. Fr. Junipero Serra, a Spanish Franciscan priest known for starting 9 missions in the 18th century in what is today the US state of California, was raised to the glory of the altars during a solemn open-air Mass at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception, in the US capital, Washington, DC.

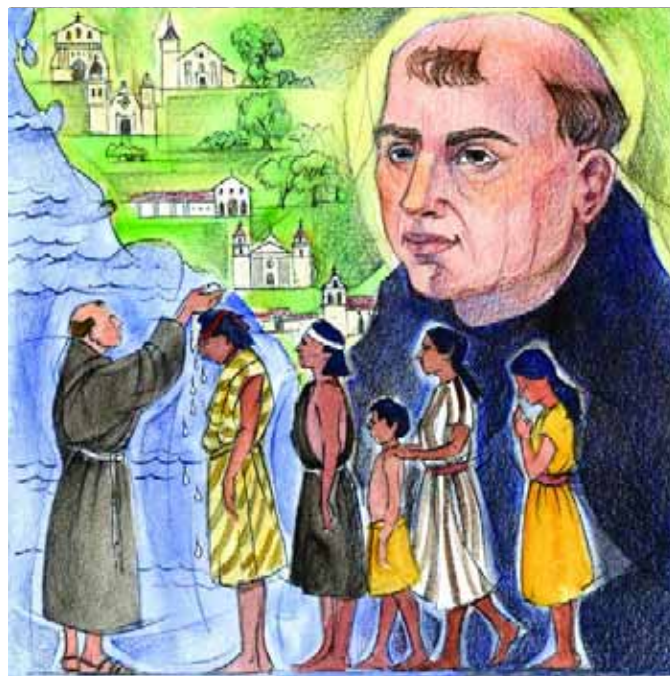
The Pope was accorded a state welcome at the White House by President Barack Obama, after which he met US bishops in St. Matthew's Cathedral. The canonization rite at the start of the evening Mass included a biography of Fr. Serra and the chanting of the Litany of the Saints. Pope Francis then pronounced the formula of canonization, officially declaring Junipero Serra a saint.



In his homily, Pope Francis held up the figure of America's new Saint, Junipero Serra, as a model of one who having experienced the joy of God's merciful anointing, in turn went out to joyfully proclaim the Good News to all people, leaving behind the security and apathy of his comfort and home. Taking his cue from St. Paul who invited Philipians to "Rejoice in the Lord

always," Pope Francis, delivering the entire homily in Spanish, said the desire for a fulfilling, meaningful and joyful life is something all have in their hearts. The struggles of everyday life seems to stand in the way of this invitation to rejoice. Our daily routine, he said, can often lead us to a kind of glum apathy which gradually becomes a habit, making our hearts grow numb. But against this, Jesus offers us the answer. He says, "Go forth! Proclaim! The joy of the Gospel is something to be experienced, something to be known and lived only through giving it away, through giving ourselves away." "For the source of our joy is "an endless desire to show mercy, the fruit of our own experience of the power of the Father's infinite mercy," the Pope stressed.

The Pope said that Jesus intended his Good News for all, embracing life as he saw it, in faces of



pain, hunger, sickness and sin, in faces of wounds, of thirst, of weariness, doubt and pity. He said, Jesus embraced life as he found it, whether dirty, unkempt or broken, and urges us to go out to tell the good news fearlessly, without prejudice, without superiority, without condescension, to all those who have lost the joy of living. Go out to proclaim the merciful embrace of the Father...who wants to anoint them with the oil of hope, the oil of salvation.

The Pope explained that mission is never the fruit of a perfect planned program, but is always the fruit of a life which knows what it is to be found and healed, encountered and forgiven. Mission is born of a constant experience of God's merciful anointing. In this regard, Pope Francis recalled the document of the Latin American Bishops, saying "life grows by being given away, and it weakens in isolation and comfort." And one such person who witnessed to the joy of the Gospel in these lands, the Pope said, is Fr. Junipero Serra. He was the embodiment of "a Church which goes forth", a Church which sets out to bring everywhere the reconciling tenderness of God. Junipero Serra left his native land and its way of life, and learned how to bring to birth and nurture God's life in the faces of everyone he met. Junipero sought to defend the dignity of the native community, to protect it from those who had mistreated and abused it. The Pope said mistreatment and wrongs still trouble us today, especially because of the hurt which they cause in the lives of many people.
