We are especially honored that our new Archbishop Blase Cupich is this year with us to preside the High Mass. Welcome to your Croatian home here in Chicago!



Grand Marshall – Mate Kovačević



This year marks 300th Anniversary of the glorious victory and honoring our heavenly patroness and rescuer, the Miraculous Madonna of Sinj, who protected Sinj from the Ottoman invasion in 1715. Ever since that day, Croatians have maintained a unique love and devotion to Mary. Thousands still make the annual pilgrimage to Sinj. Many more around the world seek Our Lady of Sinj's miraculous intervention.

The religious tradition of a Velika Gospa Procession and Mass was brought to Bridgeport in 1906 by Croatian immigrants from Sinj, the Bradarich brothers. St. Jerome's Velika Gospa tradition secured permanent and deep roots in Chicago.

Mate Kovacevic was born and raised in Croatia in a beautiful, coastal village in Dalmacija called Zvecanje, which is part of history-rich Poljica. Son of Ante and Franka, Mate has five siblings, Danka, Marija, Ivo, Zdravko and Zoran. At 24, he moved to Chicago at the invitation of his cousin, Neda Mihaljevic, nee Mindoljevic and was also welcomed by his extended family: Bozich and Grzetich. Here he began his new life and career. Mate was the second person to visit Chicago from his family as this grandfather, Iko Kovacevic came to Chicago in 1913!

As a skilled craftsman with a strong work-ethic, no job was too small or too large for Mate and he worked tirelessly to build a life for himself, never forgetting his family and his heritage back in Croatia.

In 1991, Mate married the love of his life, Maryann Renko and is the proud father of three amazing children: Ante 22, Medena 18 and Michaela 15. Ante is studying Patent Law at Chicago Kent Law School, Medena is studying biology and psychology at Loyola University and Michaela is sophomore at Loyola Academy. Maryann is a Recruiting Manager for a software company and is also active in the community as Board President for Croatian Vines Folklore and Board Secretary for Croatian-American Club Poljica.

Always giving back to his community, Mate continues to be an active supporter and leader. Highlights of his roles include Vice President of the parish board at Blessed Alojzije Stepinac church, Board Member of the Croatian Cultural Center of Chicago and active member and advisor to the Board of Directors for Croatian-American Club Poljica.

Although Mate has made a life for himself in Chicago, he has close ties to his family in Croatia and visits frequently, most recently this summer.

Sin Ante i Franke ima također dvije sestre i tri brata: Danka, Marija, Ivo, Zdravko i Zoran. U dvadeset i četvrtoj godini života došao je u Chicago na poziv svoje rodice Nede Mihaljević, rođ. Mindoljević, a lijepo su ga dočekali i rođaci iz obitelji Bozich i Grzetich. Tu je počeo svoj novi život i karijeru. Mate nije prvi iz svoje obitelji koji je došao u Chicago; njegov djed Iko Kovačević bio je jedno vrijeme ovdje još davne 1913. godine.
