

23ND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

From time to time we should stop and consider how momentous is the decision we have made to be a follower of Jesus. So easily we expect Christian life to be undisturbed our and unchallenged; so that it can become little more than engaging from time to time in consoling practices. We can fail to recognise that we are the one we are called to follow is the eternal Son of the Father, who became one of us, that through his Paschal Mystery he may lead us out of the world of selfishness and violence we have made, into a new heaven and new earth, where all is shaped by the generous and merciful ways of his Father. We should not be surprised that, as he undertakes his courageous journey to Jerusalem, his teaching has a sharp edge. It is important, however, to understand what he is asking of us, so that it will not remain little more than a seemingly impossible ideal. Luke has Jesus giving this teaching to 'great crowds'; it is not teaching for an elite group, but teaching that all those who call themselves his followers should take to heart. He is telling us that even these things must not be given a preference in our decisions that would amount to a renunciation of Christ and what he stands for. Our following must not be half-hearted, his two parables tell us. The final words of the gospel are the most challenging of all: 'none of you can be my disciples unless he gives up all his possessions'. But these very words help us to understand that Luke is not holding up to us an impossible ideal. Luke stresses the place of poverty in the Christian life; the wording of his first beatitude is blunt: 'Happy are you who are poor' (Lk 6:20); but what follows makes it clear that he does not expect all followers of Jesus to give up all their possessions - they are urged to 'lend, without hope of return' and to 'give' generously. What the Lord asks for is that, in our life commitments, we place all that is most dear to us in his hands, ready to accept whatever he asks of us. Some Christians, of course, receive a personal call to immediate renunciation - a reminder to us all of the seriousness of our following of Christ.

23. NEDJELJA KROZ GODINU

Odmah početku Isus na nas otrežnjuje grubim riječima: "Dođe li tko k meni, a ne mrzi svoga oca ili majku, ženu i djecu i sve što mu je drago, ne može biti moj učenik." Isus je propovijedao ljubav, a ne mržnju. Ova je formulacija u skladu s vreme-nom, a osim toga je hiperbolizirana i stilizirana. U semitskom načinu izražavanja mrziti znači ostaviti, napustiti. Zato Matej u evanđelju Kristove riječi formulira ovako: "Tko više ljubi oca ili majku, nije mene dostojan". U Lukinu evanđelju se manje treba brinuti i paziti na oca, majku, ženu i djecu, braću i sestre, kao i na vlastiti život. Sve su to prioriteti, ali treba znati i osjetiti koja je istina na prvome mjestu, a onda sve po tome usklađivati.

Oni koji kane poći za Isusom i slijediti ga, moraju čvrsto odlučiti i izabrati. Gospodin nikoga ne prisiljava, zna da je teško ostaviti obitelj i svoju ulogu skrbnika. Zato kao da kaže: "Dobro razmislite! Morate se jasno opredijeliti." Budući da imamo slobodu odrediti što nam je prioritet, i s obzirom da smo razumna bića, Krist u naše ruke stavlja tu veliku i tešku odluku. Ni na jednom drugom mjestu s tolikom ozbiljnošću ne govori koji su uvjeti za nasljedovanje. Nasljedovati Isusa nije jednostavno. Ono ne znači fizički kročiti za njim ili odvojiti se od svega dosadašnjeg. Potrebno je biti mudar kao vinogradar ili kralj koji se ne upuštaju u nemoguće jer znaju da im slijedi propast. Potrebno je biti mudar te prepoznati vlastite granice i mogućnosti, ali čeznuti za odabranim društvom onih koji su, spojivši razum i srce, prepoznali svoj prioritet. To je Krist, kojemu smo mi bili na prvome mjestu kad je, po volji Očevoj, došao da nam donese spasenje. Krist nas pita imamo li snage i spremnosti sve učiniti radi njega. Pita nas poimence, svakoga osobno. Jesmo li spremni odazvati se?

CANONIZATION OF MOTHER TERESA

From growing up in a single parent home, after the sudden death of her father when she was 8-years old, to being known as one of the most beloved figures in the history of the Church, the humble, emphatic, humanitarian Mother Teresa is declared a saint 19 years after her death.



Just 4 years after her father's passing, Agnes Gonxsha Bojaxhiu firs felt her calling to religion. Six years later she decided to become a nun and took the name Sister Mary Teresa after Saint Therese of Lisieux. Mother Teresa believed her life mission was to care for the hungry, the naked, the homeless, the crippled, the blind, the lepers, all those people who feel unwanted, unloved, uncared for throughout society, people that have become a burdren to the society and are shunned by everyone."

After 17 years of teaching geography and history to alleviate girl's poverty through education, she experienced her second call from God to devote herself to caring for the sick and poor. After nearly a year of lobbying Mother Teresa was granted official permission to leave her convent and pursue her new calling. In 1950, she founded the Missionaries of Charity, a Roman Catholic religious congregation. Throughout the 1950s and 1960s, she established a leper colony, an orphanage, a nursing home, a family clinic, a hospice, centers for the blind etc. During the last 50 years of her life she continued to participate in charitable works up until just months before her death. Mother Teresa died in Calcuta on September 5, 1997 at age of 87. In 1999, Pope John Paul the II waived the customary five year waiting period after death before the start of canonization process.

Mother Teresa was beatified in October 2003, and after being credited for two healings, The Vatican set today September 4, 2016, as her canonization date and formal declaration of sainthood.

KANONIZACIJA MAJKE TEREZIJE

5. rujna 1997. godine odjeknuo je glas svijetom: umrla je živa svetica. Tako bi se ukratko mogao sažeti životni put dug 87 godina majke Terezije, koja je gotovo cijeli svoj život provela pomažući drugima. I to ne pukom pomoći, nego strastvenom samilošću u najmučnijim dijelovima svijeta, kakav je, na primjer, Kalkuta, gdje je sa svojim sestrama misionarkama ljubavi s

ulica podigla na desetke tisuća gubavih, bolesnih i odbačenih ljudi. Rođena je 26. kolovoza 1910. u Skopju u albanskoj obitelji Bojaxhiu kao posljednje od troje djece.

Kad je imala tek dan, krštena je kao Agneze Gonxha. Još je kao učenica odlučila posvetiti se Bogu i otići kao misionarka u Indiju.

U Irskoj 1928. godine ulazi u Red sestara od Loreta, a 1929. putuje u Indiju, radeći ondje 17 godina kao učiteljica. 1950. godine započinje s novom misijom družbe Misionarki ljubavi, koje su se posvetile prvo zapuštenoj djeci te umirućima i drugima teškim bolesnicima, počevši od gubavaca.

Pravilo reda zasnovano je na jednostavnom geslu: "Služiti siromašnima da bi se služilo životu." Govorila je: Ne dopustite da išta žalosno uđe u vas što bi moglo biti razlog da zaboravite radost Krista Uskrsloga".

Smisao ljudskog života je u davanju. Davanjem utjelovljujemo temeljnu ljudsku vrijednost-ljubav. Majka Terezija svojim postupcima definirala je pojam ljubavi. Prepoznavši ljude u nevolji, u njenoj duši, kako sama kaže, javila se silna želja, ne da tuguje nad njihovom sudbinom, ne da ih sažalijeva... željela im je, bez obzira na opasnosti po vlastiti život, pomagati.

Majka Terezija živjela je iz dana u dan živu kršćansku vjeru koja je u konkretnim slučajevima pozivala na ljubav, mir i oprost, a osuđivala mržnju, osvetu i zlo. 1979. godine dodijeljena joj je Nobelova nagradu za mir i radeći skoro do zadnjih dana svog života, umrla je 5. rujna, 1997. godine.

Proglašena je blaženom u listopadu 2003. godine. Nakon što su dokazana dva čuda izliječenja po njezinu zagovoru papa je odlučio proglasiti je svetom, a dan proglašenja izabran je 4. rujna 2016.
