16TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

We live in a strange world, don't we? So many people begin things with good intentions, wonderful visions, and really want to make things better, both in their own lives and in the lives of others. People fall in love and get married with nothing but the best of intentions, with high hopes, with hearts filled with love, and with wonderful visions. Then, somewhere along the line, things turn sour. Life is mixture of good and evil. We are imperfect people living in an imperfect world.

The Bible tells us that Lucifer was one of the greatest of all God's angels. His name, Lucifer, means "Light Bearer." He was one of highest of God's creatures; he bore God's own light. And yet... for some reason he became the Prince of Darkness. Why? Lucifer put his will before God's will. He refused to obey God. He opted to go his own way. He defied God.

As followers of Jesus Christ, what do we do with the problem of evil? Answering the question is a big problem for all of us. The Scripture passages in today's first reading and today's gospel account suggest that we deal with evil as God deals with it, with patience and forbearance. Evil will eventually reveal itself and evil will eventually suffer the consequences it brings down upon itself.

In today's parable Jesus speaks of the weeds as darnel. Now at the beginning of the growing process darnel looks just like wheat. It's only when harvest time approaches that the difference between the two becomes apparent.

There are a couple of interesting points about the parable of Jesus. One is that when He was asked where the weeds came from Jesus replied: "An enemy has done this." He doesn't tell us why God has enemies; He simply takes it as a fact. To take a realistic view of life we simply must begin with the facts – evil exists and it comes from people who have chosen to defy God. It may not make any sense to us. We simply must take it as a fact of life. People, of their own free will, choose to defy God and do things on their own quite apart from Him. In the world of human choices, things are not as they ought to be, things are quite apart from what God intended them to be. The price of human freedom of choice is terribly costly, not only to us, but to God. Jesus Christ, the Son of God, had to pay that price.

Današnje prvo čitanje i Evanđelje potiče nas da sa zlom postupamo poput Boga, sa strpljivošću i trpezveno. Zlo će se na kraju uvijek objelodaniti i razotkriti, te će snositi posljedice. Grijeh sam sa sobom nosi patnju i kaznu.

U današnjoj evanđeoskoj prisposobi Isus govori o kukolju. Ispočetka kad tek iznikne teško ga razlikujemo od žita. Tek kad dođe vrijeme žetve vidimo razliku.

Isus veli da je to djelo neprijatelja i to je jedina adekvatna činjenica. Stvari dakle treba sagledati realno. Zlo postoji i dolazi od svakog onoga tko prezire Boga. U slobodnoj volji, koju nam je Bog dao možemo birati da činimo što je Bogu milo ili suprotno i onda snositi posljedice. Cijenu te slobode platio je sam Sin Božji za nas.
