4TH SUNDAY OF EASTER

"Whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture." Jesus uses the image of a gate today to help us understand how we are to relate to him. He is our path to "pasture," in other words, to the peace and prosperity that we long for. He shows us the way to find all that we need right there before us.

Some people, however, may think that it's better to avoid the trouble of finding the gate and thus choose to enter another way instead. But Jesus says, "Whoever does not enter a sheepfold through the gate but climbs over elsewhere is a thief and a robber." Although this is all cast in the gentle terms of an analogy about sheep, the message is actually rather stern. Jesus is telling us that if we don't follow him, we are taking the wrong course of action. He is not suggesting a kind of relativistic principle that says, "Following me is one of many good options." No. He is telling us that in order to "have life and have it more abundantly," we must follow the path that goes by way of Christ.

This isn't always the easiest path to follow. It might mean taking the long way around a situation instead of a shortcut. It might mean waiting a little while to get to that pasture instead of hopping the fence and finding it on our own terms. Insisting on using the gate may also make us look like fools to those around us. But to be truly faithful followers of Jesus, we need to trust that his way is the best way. We need to trust that, by letting him lead, we will ultimately end up in the best possible pasture. In our culture, it is becoming less and less popular to believe in one true religion, but as Christians we know that Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life.

4. VAZMENA NEDJELJA

Nedjelja je Dobrog Pastira - nedjelja molitve za duhovna zvanja. Prigoda je ovo da zahvalimo Bogu za svu dobrotu ljudi koji poput Isusa, Dobrog Pastira, čine dobro. Jer kako reče jedan, sada pokojni svećenik: *Ah, kako je lijepo činiti dobro, a to mi ne uspijeva tako lako.* Prigoda je ovo da zahvalimo svima koji mole za duhovna zvanja, kako za postojeća tako i za one koji će se odazvati Božjem pozivu.

Isus je nazvao sebe Dobrim Pastirom. Prepoznatljiva je dobrota njegova glasa. Dobri Pastir poznaje i zove imenom svaku svoju ovcu. Onaj tko je u Izraelu vidio kako stado ovaca spokojno ide za pastirom lakše će osjetiti ljepotu Božjeg odnosa prema nama izraženu u 23. psalmu: Gospodin je pastir moj: ni u čemu ja ne oskudijevam; na poljanama zelenim on mi daje odmora. Na vrutke me tihane vodi i krijepi dušu moj. Pa da mi je i dolinom smrti proći, zla se ne bojim jer ti si sa mnom....

Isus je službu pastira povjerio apostolima. Petru je rekao: *Pasi janjce moje; pasi ovce moje.* Ivan u svom evanđelju ističe i službu vratara: Isus je pastir koga vratar prepoznaje i otvara vrata. *Otvorite vrata Kristu!*, ponavljao je Kristov namjesnik sveti Ivan Pavao II. Poziv je to upućen svakom vjerniku.

Služba vratara je časna služba. Služba namjesnika glavnog Vratara, Isusa, iznimno je važna služba. Ali, vratar (namjesnik) može i zlorabiti svoju službu: otvoriti vrata kradljivcima ili s vrata vratiti one koji žele unutra. Svaki svećenik (uključujući i svakog vjernika jer svaki ima udjela u općem svećenstvu) u napasti je da zlorabi službu vratara. Bog neka nam se smiluje jer smo, a da ni sami ne znamo kome i koliko puta, zatvorili vrata, drugima prepriječili put do Krista!
