



31ST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

For they preach but they do not practice. The scribes and Pharisees may be the ones Jesus was speaking about in today's Gospel, but we must be careful not to dismiss his words when it comes to our own actions. Jesus offered a difficult challenge to those honor-seekers that we must also heed when he said, The greatest among you must be your servant. This is not the way the world usually works. Generally speaking, the idea of being a servant is considered inferior to being someone who has risen to high levels of leadership or status. But lesus wants people in positions of authority to selflessly serve those over whom they have influence. And he insists that the leaders who establish laws, rules, and guidelines do not excuse themselves from following their own directives! Practice what you preach, as the saying goes.

Whether or not we have extensive public influence, almost all of us at certain points are in a position to exercise leadership--with our children and families, with classmates, coworkers, neighbors, friends, and sometimes strangers. When these moments arise, we are called to step into this role without being hypocrites. It's important to be sure we don't issue unrealistic demands on others that we ourselves would find it burdensome or even impossible to fulfill. This requires the virtue of humility. Instead of reveling in the authority we may have at any given moment, instead of creating heavy burdens hard to carry and lay[ing] them on people's shoulders, we need to be ready and willing to walk a mile in their shoes, and lead accordingly. And Jesus tells us clearly that this servant leadership will be rewarded, for whoever humbles himself will be exalted.

31. NEDJELJA KROZ GODINU

Kršćanska tradicija, a zapravo i sam život, temelji se na ljubavi koja je otvorena. Primatelji smo beskrajne dobrote; sve stvoreno potječe iz nje; pozvani smo od te ljubavi, i biti ćemo sretni jedino ako živimo u njoj. Stoga, kad Isus traži da ljubimo Boga i čovjeka, ne traži nešto što je protivno našoj naravi. Mi potječemo od Boga koji je ljubav, stoga je u samoj našoj naravi da volimo i da budemo voljeni. Mi pokazujemo da volimo Boga onda kad volimo ono što Bog voli; kad volimo svoga bližnjega. Ako je naša ljubav otvorena i dobrostiva poput Božje, tada ćemo se brinuti za udovice, siročad i strance. Ljubav, koja je temelj kraljevstva Božjeg je zarazna - ona se širi. Ljubeći druge, kraljevstvo Božje se širi po svijetu. Dobrota koju iskazujemo drugima je oblik evangelizacije; ona snažnije govori od tisuću riječi.

Farizeji pokušavaju dovesti u pitanje Isusovu vjerodostojnost. Jedan od njih, dobar poznavatelj židovskog Zakona, pita koja je najveća zapovijed u Zakonu. U to vrijeme Zakon je uključivao 613 zapovijedi. Premda su svi zakoni bili obvezujući, pojedini zakoni su smatrani važnijim od drugih. Farizeja je zanimao Isusov stav. Isusov odgovor je u suglasju sa židovskom vjerom. On ne isključuje ni jednu zapovijed, nego se poziva na najvažniju molitvu Izraelaca -Šema. Uz potrebu ljubiti Boga svim srcem i svom dušom, Isus dodaje i svim umom, vjerojatno da bi naglasio da je cio čovjek uključen u proces ljubavi. To je način da se izrekne da ljubav prema Bogu mora obuhvatiti cijelog čovjeka. Od Isusa se tražilo da rekne jednu najveću zapovijed, a on nudi dvije. Druga, ne manje važna, jest citat iz knjige Levitskoga zakona. Na taj način Isus povezuje Zakon i Proroke i tvrdi da sva vjerska praksa ovisi o zapovijedi ljubavi.

ST. JEROME GIRLS NIGHT OUT


