WEEKLY MEDITATION for the 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time


Love is a thread that runs through the personal relationship between Peter and Jesus.

We can look to Peter's example for help in our personal relationship with Jesus. Like Peter, sometimes we are strong, and other times we are weak. Peter had his faults, but Jesus saw that his heart was sound. To be soundly at the core of Christianity like Peter, we need a personal relationship with Jesus. Otherwise, we're like someone

talking about abstractly about love — versus someone who is in love.

The question Jesus raised with his apostles was a very serious one. It concerns the identity of Jesus. Everything hinges on this: "Who do you say that I am?" Is he the Son of the living God? If so, how does this belief affect the way everyone of us lives?

It is important for us to be able to state and embrace our beliefs about Jesus. It is not enough to go through the motions of giving an abstract answer that is not em-



braced by how we live. We have to make the faith our own. Jesus is truly God and truly human, in love with us — do we live that?

Do we live our faith?

There once was an acrobat who liked to walk across Niagara Falls on a tight-rope. Whenever he did, a huge crowd would gather to watch.

"Do you believe that I can do this?" he would ask. "Yes!" the crowd would reply. Sure enough, the man would walk to one side of the Falls and back again. Then he would ask, "Do you believe that I can push a wheelbarrow across the Falls?" "Yes!" they would cry—and so he did.

Next he would ask them, "Do you believe that I can put a man in that wheelbarrow and push him safely across the tightrope?" Again the crowd would say, "Yes!"

Then the acrobat would ask, "So who will be the first to get in and try it?" With that, the crowd would go silent.
