WEEKLY MEDITATION — The Transfiguration of the Lord

On Mount Tabor, Jesus' disciples got a glimpse of the glory that was his as the Son of God. The event was meant to confirm Jesus as being the Christ, the Anointed One, but it benefited the apostles in other ways. In the transfigured Jesus, they got a glimpse of the glory of the risen Lord. Even so, they would not understand it fully until Jesus had indeed risen from the dead.

Our Lord's transfiguration came at a very difficult time in his life and in the

lives of his followers, a time of uncertainty and fear of the future. He was headed for Jerusalem, where he knew that the same fate awaited him as befell the prophets—a violent death. In order to reflect on it and pray about it, he climbed to the top of Mount Tabor.

Two thousand years later, we don't know exactly what happened on the mountaintop, but we do know he heard those marvelous words: "You are my beloved Son." Jesus was comforted

and affirmed by his heavenly Father, our Father. All could see that his Father was pleased with him and would give him the strength to face the dark and threatening future awaiting him in Jerusalem.

At times life can become dark for all of us, but there is a gentle voice that whispers to us that we are God's beloved. We need to recognize ourselves as God's beloved children in Christ and try to live our lives by the light of this truth.

From Pope Benedict's lips to our ears:

The Vatican recently issued a question-and-answer format book that teaches the truth about Jesus & the Catholic Church.

Question: Given that the Old Testament contained many stages at which God revealed Himself more and more, what is the full and definitive stage of God's Revelation?


Answer: The full and definitive stage of God's Revelation is accomplished in His Word made flesh, Jesus Christ, the mediator and fullness of Revealation. He, being the only-begotten Son of God made man, is the perfect and definitive Word of the Father.

In the sending of the Son and the gift of the Spirit, Revelation is now fully complete, although the faith of the Church must gradually grasp its full significance over the course of centuries.

"In giving us His Son, His only and definitive Word, God spoke everything to us at once in this sole Word, and He has no more to say." (St. John of the Cross)
