WEEKLY MEDITATION for the 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

"I came not to bring peace, but rather division." These are strange words to hear coming from Jesus! He did not come to cause trouble or to break-up families, but sometimes this happened. In the early days of the Church, conversion to Christianity was likely to lead to rejection by the family.

These words also stand for something very strong in his teaching. His teaching caused division and brought him into conflict with the religious es-

tablishment of his day.

Christians should not be surprised if the Gospel should divide people. Jesus' sense of justice brought him into conflict with those who exploited the weak and the poor. His integrity brought him into conflict with the dishonest. His tolerance brought him into conflict with the narrow-minded and the bigoted.


Jesus says he came to kindle a fire upon the earth. It's only an image, but

it's a powerful one. It's a symbol of judgment and purification. Fire burns up what is useless and refines what is impure.

about the vision, thinking it would move him to convert to Christianity and join her in the faith.


