## **WEEKLY MEDITATION for the 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

We need the word of God. It gives us guidance in confusing times, reassurance in times of difficulty, comfort in times of sorrow, correction in times of foolishness, challenge in time of laziness, warning in times of danger, and hope in times of despair.

God's word is always spoken in love. Just as food nourishes the body, so the word of God nourishes the mind, the heart, and the spirit. God speaks to us quietly, but there are many other voices vying for our attention.

Every day we are subjected to a blizzard of words. Never before has technology transmitted so many *human* words. How then can we hear or even recognize *God's* quiet word in the midst of this din? We can do so only by creating a little bit of stillness and quietness in our lives.



It's not enough to merely be exposed to the word; we have to act on it. Those who "keep the word" are transformed by it. What kind of *soil* do we offer God's word?

## He taught them in parables

A famous rabbi who loved to illustrate a truth by means of a story was asked by his students why he always used this approach. He explained by using this parable:

There was a time when Truth went around naked and unadorned, but people avoided him, so Truth wandered through the land unwanted. One day he met Story strolling happily along in a multi-colored robe.

"Truth, why are you so sad?" Story asked.

"I'm sad because I am so old and ugly that everyone avoids me," Truth replied.

"Nonsense!" laughed Story. "That's not why people avoid you. Here, borrow my robe and see what happens." So Truth put on Story's robe and was welcomed everywhere.

The rabbi concluded this explanation to his students by saying, "The fact is, people are often unable to face the naked Truth; they much prefer the Truth disguised. A story makes a difficult truth more palatable. A story can enable us to penetrate all the way to the heart of a great but difficult truth."


