WEEKLY MEDITATION for the 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus loved to engage the attention of his listeners with parables, stories that bring us face-to-face with challenging realities that we otherwise might shy away from or stubbornly ignore. Indeed the messages are unforgettable. Just think of some examples like the Good Samaritan, the Prodigal Son, or the Good Shepherd and his Lost Sheep.

Today's parable likens God's kingdom to a farmer's field in which the farmer's enemy (God's enemy is the Devil) sowed weeds under the cover of darkness. The farmer decides to let the weeds and the wheat grow up together, separating them only at "harvest time," with the weeds then going into the fire and the wheat into the barn.

We might yearn that Almighty God would simply vanquish evildoers and also drive away our own inner demons and just be done with it. But

God respects our human freedom. God wants us to freely love his ways and so he wants us to actively use "good"



actions to overcome "evil" — whether the evil is our own or done by others. Then, at the end of the trials of our lives, we will have proved ourselves to be God's friends by our love.
