WEEKLY MEDITATION 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time



The miracle of the loaves and fishes could be called a miracle of generosity. First food fuel of all there is the marvelous generosity of the boy who, with his gift of five loaves and two fish, made the miracle possible. It was a small thing in itself, but for the little boy it was a big thing because it was all he had. It's easy to give something that we won't really miss, but when the gift is as desperately needed by the giver that we won't really miss, but when the gift is as desperately needed by the giver as by the receiver, that is true giving. That is a sacrifice.

Then there was the marvelous generosity of Jesus. To appreciate this we need to consider the circumstances of the miracle. It's easy to reach out to others when it doesn't cause us much inconvenience. It is not so easy when it is sprung on us at an awkward moment. Here a real sacrifice is involved. We have to set aside our plans and forget about ourselves. Not only did Jesus feed the crowd, but he saw that each got as much as he wanted. Generosity is always about giving things. More often it is about giving of ourselves, our time, our talent. Giving things can be easy, but giving of oneself is never easy. Before giving Himself as food and drink in the Eucharist, Jesus gave of Himself to people in so many other ways, always meeting their needs. It is at the table of the Eucharist that Jesus nourishes us. In the Eucharist we taste the love of God. The proof that we have experienced that love will be our willingness to love others, to be generous, to sacrifice.
