WEEKLY MEDITATION for the Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest." These are among the loveliest words in the Gospel.

Life can certainly be burdensome. There is no shortage of worry, responsibility, disappointment, hurt, bitterness, guilt, illness, unemployment, addiction, difficult relationships. Because of the coming of Jesus, however, we no longer see God as someone remote and unconcerned about

us. Jesus reveals God as what He is: a loving, compassionate, forgiving Father who is passionately interested in us. It is to heal and save us that God the Father sent us His Son.

Jesus says to us, "Learn from me for I am gentle and humble of heart, and you will find rest for your souls."

Though Jesus' human power was



small, he was not weak; he was strong. He had power over the human heart. Jesus was gentle. There was no harshness in him. He knew that healing result from nurturing, not from power.

All we have to do is come to him in a spirit of love and trust, and with humility and confidence. He will give us peace.
