WEEKLY MEDITATION — 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time

When Jesus sent the apostles out to proclaim His teaching openly and to witness to Him before the word, He knew that they were fearful. So, not once but three times He said to them, "Do not be afraid." It is normal and natural that courage will sometimes fail us and that we will be afraid. Fear is not necessarily a bad thing. It sometimes has a protective function, warning us of the presence of danger. Nevertheless, fear can be a handicap. It can paralyze a person and turn him into a coward. Jesus moved His apostles beyond fear by urging them to have complete trust in God and reliance upon Him. Jesus assured them that God knew every detail of their lives and would support them in every crisis.

The Lord is at our sides, too. While at times we grow fearful, we must not allow our fears to cripple us. To live a Christian life requires courage. What is needed in life is not so much heroism as ordinary courage. Faith is a great source of courage. As people of faith, we believe that God will give us the strength to cope with whatever comes. Courage doesn't mean never being afraid. It is being afraid and overcoming it, or carrying on in spite of it. To be a disciple of Jesus, the heart of a mouse will not suffice. One needs a brave heart. May the Lord give each of us a brave heart full of trust in and reliance upon Him.
