WEEKLY MEDITATION — Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In the today's Gospel we have Peter's profession of faith. There are at least two kinds of faith. One is the faith of those who believe because they follow the traditions of their ancestors, strongly maintaining their tradition of faith. This could be called an inherited faith. Another type is the faith of those who have gained it through reason, prayer and relating to God, and especially to Jesus, true God and true man. This second type

of faith could be called a personal faith.

The question Jesus asked the apostles is the most important question in the Gospels. It concerns the identity of Jesus. He asked the question not for his own sake but for their sake. A question forces people to think about their beliefs.

It is important for us to take ownership of our beliefs — to be able to state our convictions, values and beliefs as Christians. It is not sufficient merely to repeat memorized answers.

We have to make the faith our own in order for it to be alive and influential in our lives. We need to grow in our understanding of the faith. We need to believe out of personal conviction.

There is a faith that consists only in words, and there is a faith that flows into deeds. We need God's grace, not only to profess our faith, but also to live it.

The Vatican recently issued a question-and-answer format book that teaches the truth about Jesus & the Catholic Church.

Planning for a Baptism at St. Jerome's

Parents need to be registered parishioners of St. Jerome's. Sometimes for reasons of family tradition, a baptism here is desired by parents who are practicing Catholics, but registered parishioners elsewhere. Then it is essential for the parents to bring a letter from their pastor stating that they are parishioners elsewhere.

Godparents need to be practicing (and confirmed) Catholics. If they are not St. Jerome parishioners, they need to bring a Baptismal Sponsor Certificate from the pastor of the parish where they are registered.


The reason for these Church requirements is that the child's spiritual welfare depends on having parents and Godparents who are trying to practice the Faith.
