#### WEEKLY MEDITATION

# from the Pastors Pen

#### **DEAR PARISHIONERS!**

One year ago (March, 2003) in my letter to you, I attempted to analyze the state of our parish community—

spiritually and materially, past and present—and gradually plan for the future. From a material standpoint, I mentioned possible projects that we should undertake: the purchase of additional property and the complete remodeling of our parish hall. I am happy that the time has come when we can realize our first goal, namely, the acquisition of land across from our school: 4 city lots including a house.

The cost of this parcel of land is \$700,000.00. The value of this property, as many of you who live in this area know, is much greater. A few months ago, a dear, good, and generous woman donated \$300,000.00 to our parish. Her wish is to remain anonymous. She neither wants her name to be recorded anywhere or announced! We will honor her wish. In the name of the priests and all of you, I extend our sincere and immeasurable gratitude to her. May Our Lord reward her goodness with His goodness.

I have borrowed from the Archdiocese of Chicago the \$400,000.00 balance required for the purchase. We must repay this loan over the next 3 years. The "closing" will take place on April 20. The following week we will open a parish account to be known as the "St. Jerome Property Fund." Therefore, I am now asking those who are able and willing to please contribute to this beneficial cause so that we can repay the loan and move forward.

I am sincerely grateful to attorney Janet Badrov Cuomo for the legal assistance she offered in handling this matter. Without her help this project would have been difficult to accomplish.

I suggest that soon after the 20th of April we begin tearing down the house and clearing the trees from the property so that it is ready for use on Velika Gospa. For the time being, I feel that the land needs to be used for parking. Later on we can plan for the use of the entire area as needed in the coming years. I hope that the realization of this project will be a sign of the thriving spirit and growth of our parish community, which, with the help of Our Lord, will journey forward blessedly and successfully.
