# WEEKLY MEDITATION

# - Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God

Today's Gospel passage mentions the visit of the shepherds to the manger at Bethlehem. Mary is pictured as treasuring all of her experiences and pondering them in her heart. The circumcision of Jesus, the ceremony in which Jesus received the name given him by the angel, is then de-"Jesus" scribed. The name means "the Lord saves". This

indicates the role he has in God's plan of salvation. With our Blessed Mother, we can reflect on these readings. With Mary, we can relive the experience of seeing the shepherds come and honor her Son. With Mary, we can relive the solemn experience of Jesus' reception of his Holy Name. With Mary we are invited to treasure all these things and ponder them in our own hearts. at the level of our being, where we are most truly ourselves. This is the place deep inside ourselves where our understanding and free will, where our imagina-

tion and memory and emotions come together and we make our choices for good or for evil with regard to our role in the drama of salvation. For just as Jesus had his role in this drama, along with the Father and the Holy Spirit, and just as Mary had a role in this drama, so do we. It is by far the most important thing about us. Today's feast day is an invitation to reflect on this role, as Mary did, and entrust our living out this role to her motherly intercession with her Son. Then, we too will become bearers of Christ to the world.
