WEEKLY MEDITATION

At a critical moment in His public ministry Christ posed a question to the apostles concerning His true identity: "Who do people say that I am?". Recognizing who Christ is and what He means in our lives is a priority for all who call themselves Christians. We cannot hope to form a meaningful relationship with Christ unless we know who He really is, and the real answer depends on our readiness to follow Him in our daily lives by being prepared to follow the path of pain, sorrow, and distress that He trod. Suffering and the cross present us with a problem because they go against the grain of life. We all want ease, comfort, and luxury. Most of us are quite willing to follow Christ, but when trouble comes our way we are forced to realize that we cannot have Christianity without tears. The cross and suffering stand fair and square in the center of life and are a great mystery. Jesus is showing us that suffering is the measure of a person, the test of love for friends, and a necessary requirement of His followers. We find the cross everywhere in life, and do not have to go searching for it. It's already on our shoulders in parenthood, unemployment, the loss of a loved one, and the pain of strained relationships. All we need to do is to carry it willingly by offering up our daily sufferings with those of Christ. One of the paradoxes of the Gospel is that life comes from death. In the midst of this season of growth when the countryside is teeming with life, Jesus reminds us that only when we die will we truly live.

Happy Father's Day

The idea to celebrate Father's Day as a day for children to thank their dads for all they do for them came from Sonora Smart Dodd of Spokane, Washington. Because her mother died when Sonora was a little girl, her father raised her. Later, realizing all that he had done for her, she decided to thank him for all of his love in a special way. Since her father was born in the month of June, she organized the first observance of Father's Day on June 19, 1910 in Washington. In 1923 President Calvin Coolidge proclaimed the third Sunday in June as national Father's Day.
