#### WEEKLY MEDITATION

Jesus didn't hold anything back from His disciples. He told them that things would be difficult. When He spoke about the world He was very realistic. He spoke about wars and revolutions, earthquakes, plagues and famines, persecution and imprisonment, betrayal, hatred and killings. He told them that such happenings would provide them with an opportunity to bear witness to Him and to the Gospel. It is in times of darkness that the light is needed, in times of falsehood that the truth is needed, in times of hatred that love is needed, in times of war that peace is needed, and in difficult times that Christian witness is needed. Faith is not a way of wishing that things were different. No one is helped by denial. Faith gives us the strength to cope with reality as it is.
