WEEKLY MEDITATION

Advent issues a spiritual wake-up call to us, and has an awakening power. Unless we are spiritually awake, we are only half living. In this respect some people are little better than sleepwalkers. They have eyes but do not see, and ears but do not hear. Spirituality is about waking up. It is about understanding things, seeing things, hearing things. To be spiritually awake means to be attentive to God and to others. It means to be living in love. We have two options: we can be a watcher or a sleeper. Jesus urges us to stay awake, to be on our guard, to be on the watch. We have nothing to fear and everything to gain from answering Advent's wake-up call. This is the first Sunday of a new liturgical year. Another year has come and gone. Life is short and time is passing, so we need to get on with our work. We must seize the day. We shall pass through this world but once. Therefore, any good that we can do to any human being, let us do it now; let us not defer it or neglect it, for we shall not pass this way again.

ADVENT—Latin *ad-venio*, to come to. Advent is a period beginning with the Sunday nearest to the feast of [St. Andrew the Apostle](#) (30 November) and embracing four Sundays. The first Sunday may be as early as 27 November, and then Advent has twenty-eight days, or as late as 3 December, giving the season only twenty-one days.
